RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine to execute all documents necessary to approve the installation of one metal shipping container at Cherry Park for the use as a concession stand, furnished entirely by the Long Beach Plaza Little League, approve a Right-of-Entry Permit for the installation, and accept the non-monetary donation of material and labor equivalent to approximately \$3,000.

DISCUSSION

On January 10, 2013, the Parks and Recreation Commission approved the installation of one shipping container at Cherry Park (Park) to allow the Long Beach Plaza Little League (League) to store their baseball field maintenance items on site. Subsequently, the League has made a request to add a second shipping container to be used as a concession stand. The purpose of the concession stand is to both provide food and beverages to attendees and to use any profits to maintain the league and keep league fees affordable.

The League has requested permission to place one metal shipping container (20' long x 8' wide x 8' foot high) on the existing concrete behind the ball diamond backstop. (Attachment) The League has also requested that they run an electrical line, from the Park electrical box to the proposed concession stand in order to obtain the necessary electricity for lighting and refrigeration needed to operate the concession. The League will hire a licensed electrical contractor perform the electrical work. The League will comply with the City's permit and insurance requirements.

The League understands that, in addition to bearing all costs associated with the installation of the improvement, the League will be responsible to keep the concession container free from graffiti and in an acceptable manner as approved by the Director of Parks, Recreation and Marine.



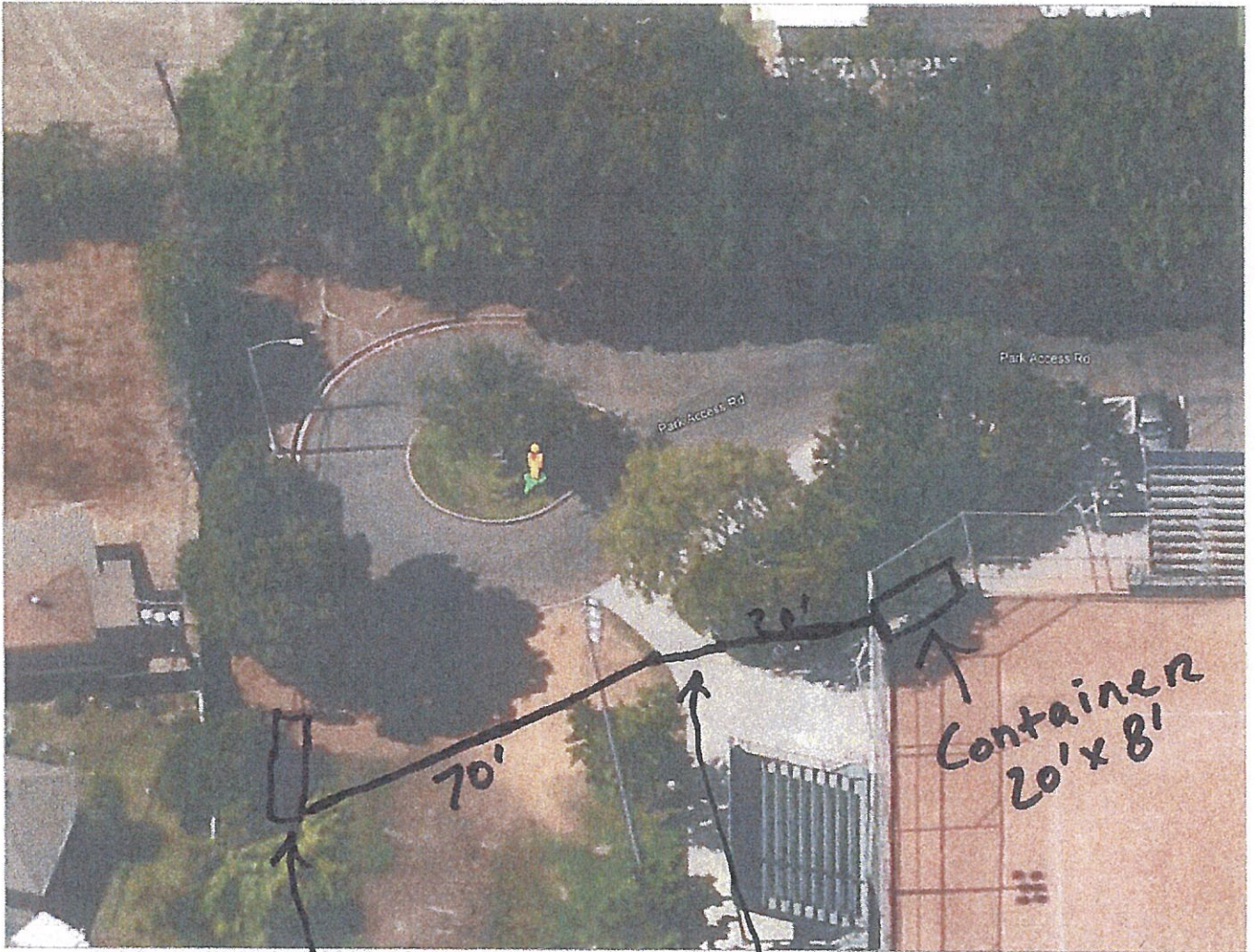
