A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PARKEON, INC. WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, TO PURCHASE UP TO 41 MULTI-SPACE PARKING METERS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$350,000

WHEREAS, a City review team met with four providers of multi-space parking meters and Parkeon meters were selected; and

WHEREAS, the City launched a 90-day trial of five new Parkeon pay-and-display parking pay stations that replaced 22 single-space parking meters in The Pike downtown. These solar-powered electronic kiosks accept MasterCard and Visa debit/credit cards and coins; and

WHEREAS, this demonstration project was developed to address the challenge of patrons wishing to park in The Pike area where the meter rate is \$2.00 per hour. The Parkeon multi-space parking meters provide more flexible payment options, which provides greater convenience for motorists; and

WHEREAS, many benefits have been realized from the operation of these Parkeon multi-space meters, including better management of City parking operations. Down time has been reduced because staff is notified through wireless communication of any problems or malfunctions. The use of solar power also allows for an environmentally-friendly solution that enables real time credit and debit card payments; and

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids to purchase these multi-space parking meters and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;
