Shall an ordinance be adopted that imposes a business license tax on medical marijuana collectives of not more than 10% of annual gross receipts, on cultivation/grow facilities of not more than \$50 per square foot and on non-profit medical marijuana collectives of not more than \$10 per square foot, adjusted annually for inflation?
