FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35502

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35502 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 8, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on February 4, 2020, by and between SHREE GANESH, INC., a California corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 802 E. Pacific Coast Highway, Long Beach, CA 90806, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with providing temporary lodging services for human and social services programs in the Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 35502 (the "Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide the specialized services as described in Request for Proposals No. HE19-131 for Temporary Lodging Services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to add ten (10) days to the initial term to reflect a one-year period and extend the term of the contract one (1) additional year;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "2. <u>TERM</u>. The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on October 1, 2019, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2021, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement, or unless the services or the Project is completed sooner. City shall have the option to extend the term of this Agreement for one (1) additional one-year period, at the discretion of City Manager."
- 2. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
