

RESOLUTION NO. C-28477

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE COMMERCIAL TRASH CONTAINERS THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ONTARIO AND CONSOLIDATED FABRICATORS CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase commercial trash containers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ontario has a contract with Consolidated Fabricators Corporation for the purchase of these commercial trash containers through its Purchase Order No. 12593 and accompanying contract ("Ontario Contract"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the Ontario Contract will facilitate acquisition of these commercial trash containers as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Ontario Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated hereby by this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to

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1 enter an agreement with Consolidated Fabricators Corporation to purchase commercial  
2 trash containers of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the City of Ontario  
3 pursuant to the Ontario Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of  
4 Long Beach and Consolidated Fabricators Corporation and the purchase by the City of  
5 Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Ontario in  
6 an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00 plus tax, for a period extending until the warranty  
7 on the commercial trash containers expires.


8 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the  
9 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
