MINUTES:

It was moved by Commissioner Saafir, seconded by Commissioner Infelise and carried that the minutes of the regular meeting of April 29, 2009, be approved as prepared. After discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Karatsu, seconded by Commissioner Infelise and carried to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of April 29, 2009, with correction. REQUEST TO ADOPT PROPOSED CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION POLICY 1.80:

EXCEPTION TO THE RULES MAY BE AUTHORIZED

The Secretary presented a proposed Civil Service Commission Policy 1.80 – Exception to the Rules May be Authorized and staff report prepared by him to the Commission for approval. Commissioner Saafir questioned the clarity of 3 & 4 in the proposed policy. The Secretary advised the Commission that at the time of the request, the Appointing Authority, on its request, must provide justification under the four sections indicated, and if all four sections are not addressed, the Commission has the option to request additional information or approve or deny the request. Cynthia Stafford, Personnel Services Officer, Public Works, addressed the Commission with some recommended changes to the policy to allow for the Appointing Authority's designee to make request to the

Commission in order to speed up the requests. After discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Infelise, seconded by Commissioner Saafir and carried to approve Civil Service Commission Policy 1.80 – Exception to the Rules May be Authorized. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

APPEAL OF DEMOTION:
