Subject:

Restriction on Out-of-State Travel

Due to budget constraints in the current fiscal year, as of November 1, 2007, City Manager approval is required for all out-of-state travel by City Manager-directed department employees for all City-related business, including, but not limited to, conferences, meetings and trainings. In-state travel should also be limited to critical City business required for the effective continuation of current operations only. While not mandatory, non-City Manager departments are requested to comply with this policy as well to ensure Citywide consistency and reduce discretionary spending.

This policy will remain in effect until further notice.
