**Recommendation:**

Approve the expenditure of \$20,000 as a reward for information helping to solve the murder of Carina Mancera and Jennabel Anaya on August 6.

**Discussion:**

On August 6, Long Beach resident Carina Mancera and her four year old daughter Jennabel Anaya were shot to death on the corner of Locust Ave. and 9<sup>th</sup> St. This tragedy has caused grief throughout the city. At this time, the Long Beach Police believe the offer of a reward may help lead to solving this case. The \$40,000 reward would be funded by the County of Los Angeles and the City of Long Beach.

The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors will consider an expenditure of \$20,000 at its August 16 meeting. The City should also provide \$20,000, to be paid from the Police Department Budget.
