WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds because Zonar Systems, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or individual that could or would bid for the furnishing of these inspection and monitoring services and hardware to the City;
