A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING, AMENDMENTS TO THE LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO SUBMIT CERTIFIED COPIES OF THIS RESOLUTION TOGETHER WITH ALL SUPPORTING MATERIALS AND THE ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SOUTHEAST AREA DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT PLAN (SEADIP)(PD-1) TO THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL AND CERTIFICATION

WHEREAS, on _____, the City Council of the City of Long Beach amended certain provisions of the Long Beach Zoning Regulations of the City of Long Beach related to amendments to Subarea 17 of the Southeast Area Development and Improvement Plan (SEADIP)(PD-1); and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to submit the above referenced zoning regulation amendments to the California Coastal Commission for its review as implementing ordinances of the Long Beach Local Coastal Program (LCP); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission and City Council gave full consideration to all facts and the proposals respecting the amendments to the zoning regulations at a properly noticed and advertised public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the proposed changes to the LCP by adopting the amendments to the zoning regulations. The proposed zoning regulation amendments are to be carried out in a manner fully consistent with the Coastal Act and

1 become effective in the Coastal Zone immediately upon Coastal Commission certification
2 and approval; and

3 WHEREAS, environmental documentation has been prepared, certified,
4 received and considered as required by law, and the City Council hereby finds that the
5 proposed amendments will not adversely affect the character, livability or appropriate
6 development of the surrounding properties and that the amendments are consistent with
7 the goals, objectives and provisions of the General Plan;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
9 follows:

10 Section 1. The Director of Development Services of the City of Long
11 Beach is hereby authorized to and shall submit a certified copy of this resolution, together
12 with appropriate supporting materials, to the California Coastal Commission as an
13 amendment to the Local Coastal Program that will take effect automatically upon
14 Commission approval pursuant to the Public Resources Code or as an amendment that
15 will require formal City Council adoption after Coastal Commission approval.

16 Section. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
17 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
