Honorable Mayor Garcia and Council Members:

Long Beach residents are being subjected, without recourse, seven months a year to prolonged periods of excessive, harmful amplified noise by city-permitted events because it is allowed under Long Beach Municipal Code 8.80.280.

Therefore, we are petitioning you to amend LBMC 8.80.280 to add the underlined words:

The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to occasional outdoor or indoor gatherings, public dances, shows and sporting and entertainment events, provided said events are conducted pursuant to a permit or license or other entitlement issued by the City relative to the staging of said events and provided (1) the sounds emitted from amplifying devices at such events not exceed the permissible sound limits of Long Beach Municipal Codes 8.80.150 through 8.80.180 when the sounds reach nearby residences and (2) set-up and tear-down for the events not occur between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. except to remove only equipment that might be damaged during the night.

*We are **NOT against city-permitted outdoor events.*** We understand their benefits.

However, the health and well-being of hundreds of people living next to places where city-permitted outdoor events occur is at risk.

The first attachment shows decibel readings taken randomly at a high-rise residential building next to city-permitted outdoor events during one four-week period. In *all* of the readings the decibel level is significantly above the maximum noise levels of the city noise code. Talking in our homes over these excessive sounds is like talking over the sound of a working garbage disposal.

In most of these events, the amplified bass (not shown in these readings) relentlessly pierces our homes, often driving us away from our homes to protect ourselves from the sounds. Often the sounds rattle objects in our homes.

Evening events on week-days interfere with getting a good night's sleep before work the next day. Additionally, we often have our sleep interrupted at night by the sounds of metal clanking against metal and truck back-up alarms sounding off as facilities are set up and torn down.

Police refuse to respond to our calls for protection or take reports because LBMC 8.80.280 allows exemptions to the city's noise ordinances for "occasional" events if the events are permitted by the city.

While any given city-permitted event occurs only once a year, there are so many different city-permitted outdoor events adjacent to high-density residential buildings between the ocean and

East Ocean Boulevard, that multi-day outdoor events occur almost every week in this area from April to October. The cumulative effect of one or more events up to 12 hours a day, 3 or more days in a row, almost every week is not "occasional" to people living next to these events.

Three high-density residential buildings on East Ocean—Villa Riviera, International Towers, and Long Beach Towers, at 800, 700, and 600 East Ocean respectively—were built many years before LBMC 8.80.280 was enacted. They are so old they cannot be air conditioned. On hot days people who live in units facing city-permitted events are forced to choose between shutting their windows to help mitigate the amplified sounds or opening their windows to cool off and receiving the full blast of the amplified sounds in their homes.

Too much exposure to excessive noise can lead to stress, anxiety, high blood pressure, gastrointestinal problems, chronic fatigue, and hearing problems according to the Center for Disease Control.


California Noise Law 46000 states that (a) Excessive noise is a serious hazard to the public health and welfare, ... (f) All Californians are entitled to a peaceful and quiet environment without the intrusion of noise which may be hazardous to their health or welfare, [and] (g) It is the policy of the state to provide an environment for all Californians free from noise that jeopardizes their health or welfare. The amendment we are requesting would put Long Beach in compliance with California Law.

The amendment does not apply to the level of amplified sound at the stage of permitted events, only to the sound when it reaches nearby residences. The goals of the amendment can be achieved with available techniques and technologies that would mitigate amplified sounds before they reach nearby residences.

Please **protect our health and welfare**. Please **amend Long Beach Municipal Health and Safety Code 8.80.280** to protect us from amplified sounds intruding on us in our homes and effecting our well-being.

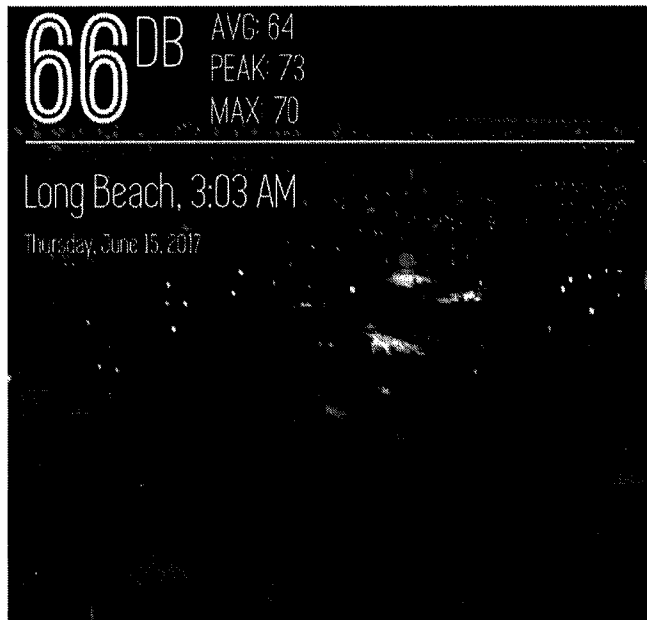

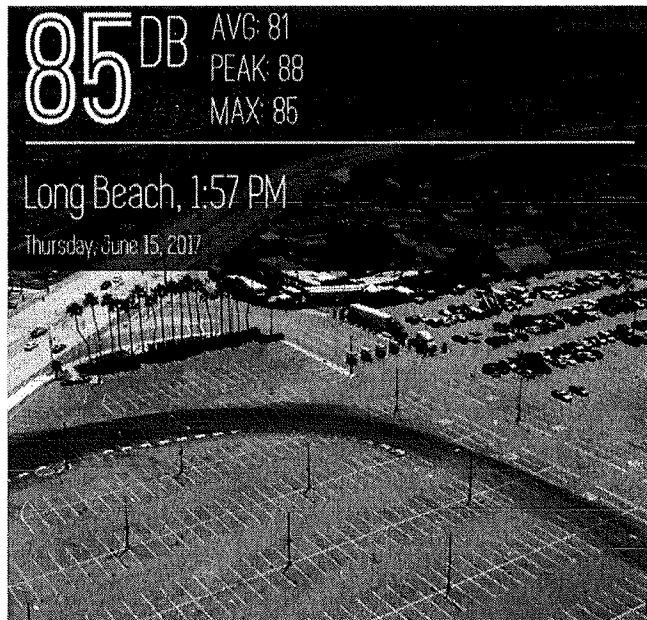

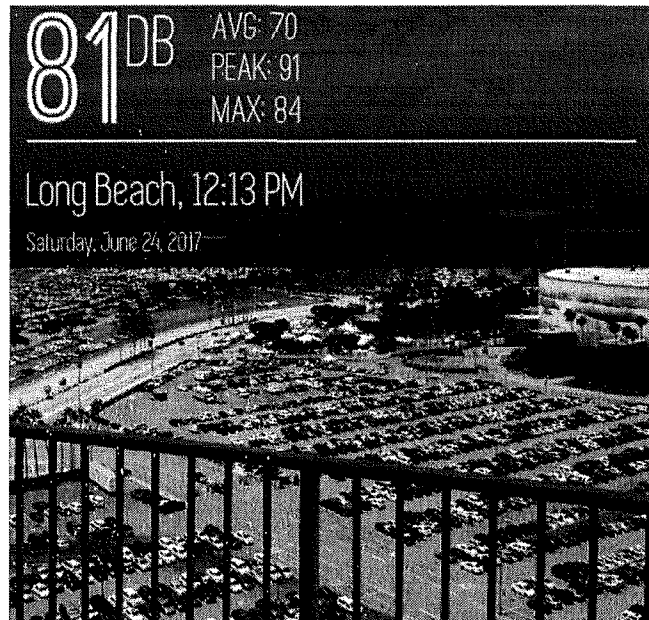

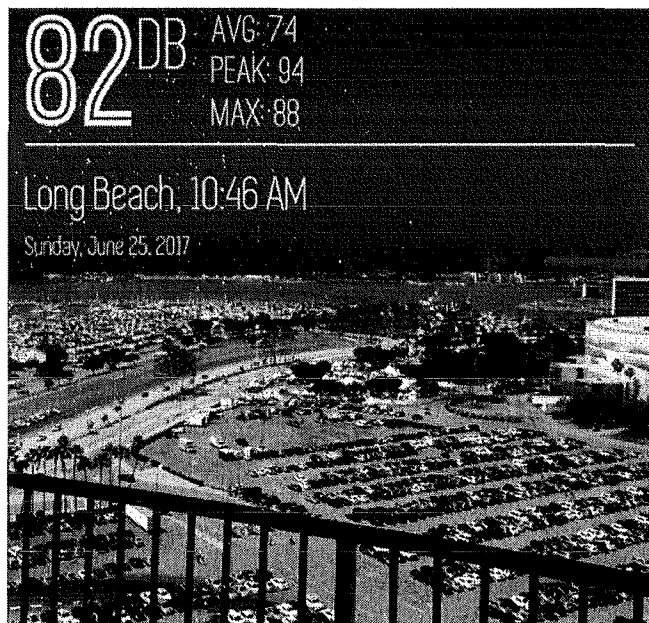

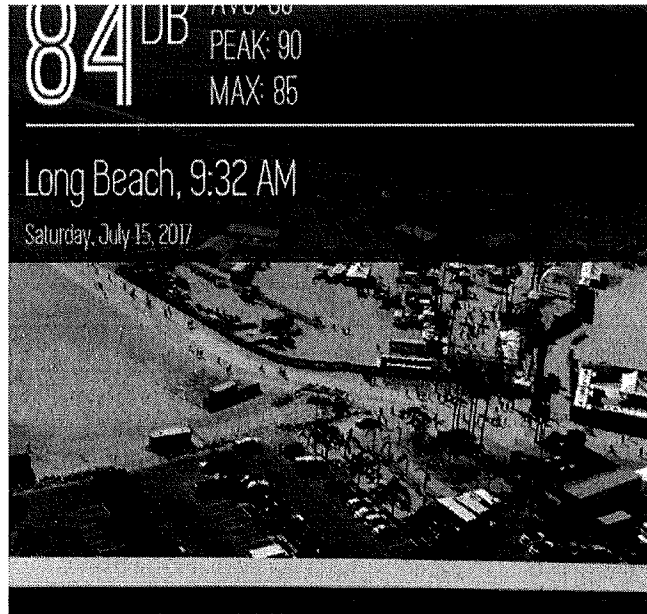

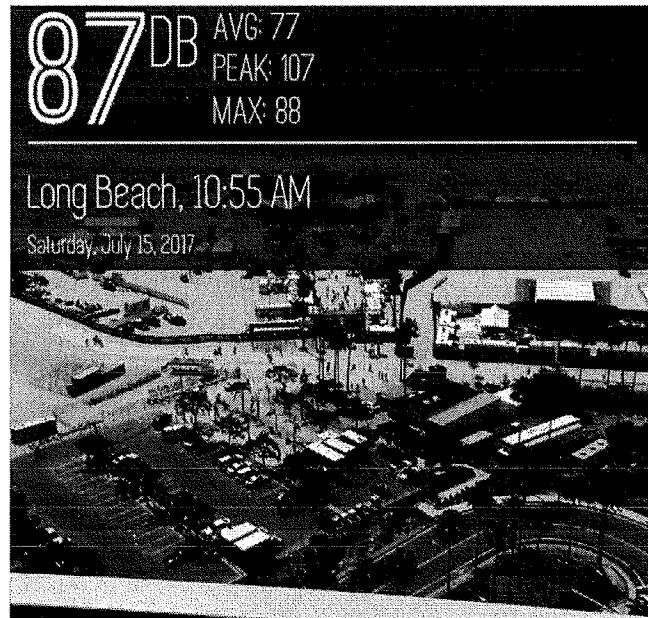
