PROJECT: Low Flow Diversion Systems and Two Vortex Separation Systems at 9th Place and Bluff Park

CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER AUTHORIZATION NO. 3

PART 1 (Reason for Change)

- 1.1 The work outlined in this Change Order was not included in the original scope of work assigned to the prime contractor. However this work needs to be done to complete the commissioning of the Low Flow Diversion (LDF) stations at 9th Place and Bluff Park. The scope of this change order includes the following:
 - 1.1.1 This scope of work is a three part operation for the complete interface between the Low Flow Diversion Stations at Bluff Park and 9th Place with the L.A. County Sanitation District (LACSD) SCADA System and Long Beach Public Works (LBPW) SCADA System.
 - 1.1.2 The interface will provide the following:
 - 1.1.2.1 Capability for LACSD to monitor in real time and remotely shut down the subject LFD stations in an emergency situation.
 - 1.1.2.2 Capability of Long Beach Public Works to monitor in real time and control the LFD stations remotely.
 - 1.1.3 The sites involved in this scope of work are as follows:
 - 1.1.3.1 LACSD SCADA System
 - 1.1.3.2 LBPW City Yard SCADA System.
 - 1.1.3.3 LBPW 9Th Place LFD Pump Station.
 - 1.1.3.4 LBPW Bluff Park LFD Pump Station.
 - 1.1.3.5 PRA Remote Monitoring Station.
- 1.2 The storm water diverted in each of the LFD stations is discharged into the Long Beach Water Department sanitary sewer system and subsequently is treated at the LA County Sanitation treatment facility. A requirement of operating the LFD stations is to obtain industrial waste discharge permits from LA County Sanitation District for each of the LFD stations. A condition of approval of the industrial waste discharge permits is compliance with the above SCADA requirements. As part of this scope of work the contractor will assist the City in obtaining the Industrial Waste Discharge Permits from LA County Sanitation District for the LFD stations at 9th Place and Bluff Park.

PART 2 (Description of Change)

2.1 Provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools and incidentals required to construct and commission the operation of the SCADA interface system between the two LFD stations (9th Place & Bluff Park) and the following SCADA systems:

1.2.1.1 LACSD SCADA System

1.2.1.2 LBPW City Yard SCADA System.

1.2.1.3 LBPW 9th.Place LFD Pump Station.

1,2,1,4 LBPW Bluff Park LFD Pump Station.

2.2 Provide assistance in obtaining the Industrial Waste Discharge Permits from LA County Sanitation District for the LFD Stations at 9th Place and Bluff Park
