3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO PURCHASE COMMERCIAL TRASH
6 CONTAINERS THROUGH THE MASTER AGREEMENT
7 BETWEEN THE LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE
8 DISTRICT AND CONSOLIDATED FABRICATORS
9 CORPORATION

11 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
12 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
13 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
14 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

15 WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase commercial trash containers
16 ("Containers"); and

17 WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Community College District has a Master
18 Agreement for the purchase of these Containers, Contract No. 40020 ("District Contract");
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the District Contract will facilitate
21 acquisition of these Containers as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
24 District Contract considerably more funds would be required;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
26 follows:

27 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein
28 by this reference.

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2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with Consolidated Fabricators Corporation to purchase commercial trash containers of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the Los Angeles Community College District pursuant to the District Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Consolidated Fabricators Corporation, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the Los Angeles Community College District in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 including tax and shipping, for a period of one year, with the option of renewing for two additional one year periods, extending until the warranty on the commercial trash containers expires.


3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
