The Contractor shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete this work

12. As directed in TO-CO-030-Component 6A Area Increase {200,000sf to 353,398sf}, the Contractor was directed to provide all labor, materials, and equipment to increase the area of the RAC Ready-Return and Storage surface lots to accommodate the proposed RAC program requirements. The Contractor shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete this work

13. As directed in TO-CO-038-Component 1B BSO Lockers, the Contractor was directed to provide all labor, materials, and equipment to modify the plans and specifications for the airline storage lockers. The Contractor shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete this work
