

RESOLUTION NO. RES-20-0041

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020, FOR THE TWO BALLOT MEASURES WHICH HAD BEEN SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution Nos. RES-19-0107 and RES-19-0179, duly call and provide for the holding of a Special Municipal Election on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, to submit to a vote of the qualified electors of the City two (2) ballot measures; and

WHEREAS, the Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, March 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk duly canvassed the returns of the election and has transmitted the results to the City Clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. A true and correct copy of the canvass of the votes cast for and against the ballot measures are provided in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The ballot measures appeared on the ballot as follows:

A. Measure A: To maintain 911 emergency response services, police, fire, parks, libraries, repair streets, and support general services, shall an ordinance be adopted extending the City of Long Beach's Transactions and Use Tax beyond 2027, generating approximately \$60

1 million annually, at a 1% rate until December 31, 2022, at ¾% until
2 September 30, 2027, and at 1% from October 1, 2027 until ended by
3 voters, requiring a citizens' advisory committee and annual independent
4 audits, with all funds remaining in Long Beach?

5 B. Measure B: To provide funding for student arts education
6 programs, community arts, music, cultural programs and organizations,
7 local museums and theaters, and the Long Beach Convention and
8 Entertainment Center, and maintain other general fund programs shall a
9 measure be adopted increasing Long Beach's general transient occupancy
10 (hotel bed) tax rate from 6% to 7%, paid for by hotel/motel guests,
11 generating approximately \$2.8 million dollars annually, until ended by
12 voters, requiring audits and local control of funds?

13 Section 3. It is determined and declared that at the Special Municipal
14 Election, 49,676 votes were cast in favor of Measure A and 49,660 votes were cast
15 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is
16 hereby approved.

17 Section 4. It is determined and declared that at the Special Municipal
18 Election, 59,190 votes were cast in favor of Measure B and 40,775 votes were cast
19 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is
20 hereby approved.

21 Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
