RECOMENDATION:

Adopt the attached resolution consenting to the establishment of Anaheim Street Bridge Over Long Beach Freeway, within the City of Long Beach, as part of the System of Highways of Los Angeles County. (District 1)

DISCUSSION

Following the Loma Prieta earthquake in October 1989, emergency legislation known as Senate Bill 36X was enacted. The law requires that all existing publicly owned bridges in California be inspected and that those found to have a seismic structural deficiency be upgraded and retrofitted to conform to specific structural standards. The bill further provides for the County of Los Angeles (County) to be the lead agency for inspecting and retrofitting all non-state highway bridges within the County.

To enable the County to administer the seismic retrofit project for the subject bridge, it is necessary to temporarily transfer jurisdiction of the bridge to the County. Jurisdiction will be relinquished back to the City after the completion of this project.

Deputy City Attorney Lori A. Conway prepared the subject resolution on May 31, 2007.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Lori A. Conway on June 11, 2007, and by Budget and Performance Management Bureau Manager David Wodynski on June 20, 2007.

The project cost is currently estimated to be \$586,800 with Federal reimbursement being \$423,900 and the State reimbursement being \$14,000. The estimated non-Federally reimbursable portion to be funded by the City would be \$148,900. The City's actual share will be based upon a final accounting after completion of the project.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on July 3, 2007, will allow commencement of this project by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works.

FISCAL IMPACT



3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH CONSENTING TO THE
5 ESTABLISHMENT OF ANAHEIM STREET BRIDGE OVER
6 LONG BEACH FREEWAY, WITHIN SAID CITY, AS PART
7 OF THE SYSTEM OF HIGHWAYS OF THE COUNTY OF
8 LOS ANGELES

10 WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors on April 17,
11 2007, duly adopted a Resolution declaring the bridge portion of Anaheim Street Bridge
12 over Long Beach Freeway, in the City of Long Beach, to be a part of the County System
13 of Highways for the purpose of performing a seismic safety retrofit of the bridge at the
14 aforementioned location, as provided in Sections 1700-1702 inclusive of the Streets and
15 Highways Code of the State of California; and

16 WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors by said Resolution requested the
17 City Council of the City of Long Beach to give its consent to allow the County to perform
18 seismic safety retrofit of this bridge ("Retrofit Work"), within the City of Long Beach; and

19 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the County of Los Angeles Board of
20 Supervisors to perform the Retrofit Work, provided the consent of the City Council of the
21 City of Long Beach shall first be given under the terms herein;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
23 follows:

24 Section 1. Consent to Inclusion in County Highway System - This City
25 Council does hereby consent to include this bridge as part of the System of Highways of
26 the County of Los Angeles as provided in the Sections 1700-1702 inclusive of the Streets
27 and Highways Code of the State of California, for the limited purpose of performing a
28 seismic safety retrofit of this bridge at this location.

1 Section 2. Indemnification - That the City of Long Beach shall fully
2 indemnify, defend, and hold the County of Los Angeles harmless in connection with any
3 and all claims, liability, injury (as defined by Government Code Section 810.8) or damage
4 relating to this bridge that is not caused by County's Retrofit Work.

5 Section 3. Roadway Maintenance - The City of Long Beach will remain
6 the owner of the bridge and remain responsible for all roadway maintenance activities on
7 the portion of Anaheim Street Bridge over Long Beach Freeway prior to the start of
8 construction by the County and following the completion and field acceptance of said
9 construction. Following completion of construction and County's field acceptance of the
10 Retrofit Work, the City of Long Beach accepts ownership and full responsibility for all
11 roadway maintenance, including relating to the Retrofit Work.

12 Section 4. Environmental Documentation - The City of Long Beach does
13 hereby consent to adopt and concurs with the environmental findings pursuant to the
14 California Environmental Quality Act that has been adopted by the County in connection
15 with the Retrofit Work.

16 Section 5. Warranty for Retrofit Work - The County hereby assigns to the
17 City of Long Beach all of its right, title, and interest in and to any unexpired portion of a
18 one-year warranty granted to the County by the construction contractor performing the
19 Retrofit Work following completion of construction of the Retrofit Work and field
20 acceptance of said construction by County. The City of Long Beach agrees to accept
21 said assignment as its sole remedy against the County in connection with defects relating
22 to said Retrofit Work.

23 Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
24 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
