RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to adopt a resolution consenting to requests from the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District and the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District to consolidate Governing Board Member elections with the City of Long Beach Primary Nominating Election to be held on April 10, 2012.

DISCUSSION

The Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District (LBUSD) and the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District (LBCCD) have requested consolidation of their governing bodies' elections with the City's Primary Nominating Election on April 10, 2012. Accordingly, the City Clerk Department is prepared to conduct the LBUSD Board of Education Election in LBUSD Districts 2 and 4, and the LBCCD Board of Trustee Election in LBCCD Districts 2 and 4.

FISCAL IMPACT

Long Beach Unified School District and Long Beach Community College District have agreed to reimburse the City for their pro rata share of election costs.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, CONSENTING TO
REQUESTS FROM THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE
LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LONG BEACH
COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO CONSOLIDATE
GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER ELECTIONS WITH THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON APRIL 10, 2012

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach has called a
municipal election in the City of Long Beach to be held on April 10, 2012, for the election
of certain City officers pursuant to the applicable provisions of the City Charter and the
laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, both the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School
District and the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District have
requested the City Council of the City of Long Beach to consent to the consolidation of
Governing Board Member elections with the City's Primary Nominating Election pursuant
to the provisions of Section 10400 et seq., of the California Elections Code for the
purpose of electing two members of the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified
School District and two members of the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community
College District; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable (1) that these Governing Board Member
elections be consolidated with the City's municipal election to be held on the same date;
and (2) that within the City of Long Beach precincts, polling places and election officers
for the three elections be the same; and (3) that the City Clerk canvass the returns of the

1 municipal election and the Governing Board Member elections; and (4) that these
2 elections be held in all respects as if there were only one election;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
4 follows:

5 Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10400 et seq., of
6 the California Elections Code, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does consent
7 and agree to the consolidation of the Governing Board Member elections with the City's
8 municipal election on Tuesday, the 10th day of April, 2012, for the purpose of electing
9 two members of the Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School District and
10 two members of the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District.

11 Section 2. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only
12 one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

13 Section 3. The Board of Education of the Long Beach Unified School
14 District and the Board of Trustees of the Long Beach Community College District
15 recognize that additional costs will be incurred by the City because of this consolidation
16 and have agreed to reimburse the City for their pro rata share of such costs.

17 Section 4. The City Clerk of the City of Long Beach is directed to file a
18 certified copy of this resolution with the Registrar of Voters of the County of Los Angeles.

19 Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
20 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
