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RESOLUTION NO. RES-23-0114

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH GO2ZERO STRATEGIES, LLC ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE CITY OF ONTARIO, CALIFORNIA, FOR PROFESSIONAL SOLID WASTE CONSULTING SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000, UNTIL THE CONTRACT EXPIRES ON NOVEMBER 15, 2024, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF ONTARIO IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment, and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to obtain professional solid waste consulting services on an as-needed basis to comply with Senate Bill 1383; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works researched procurement options, and discovered that the City of Ontario, California completed an open, fair, transparent, and competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, The City of Ontario has an agreement with Go2Zero Strategies, LLC for on-call solid waste consulting services (the "Consulting Agreement"), for a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), expiring on November 15, 2024; and

1 WHEREAS, Go2Zero Strategies, LLC has decades of experience in waste
2 reduction and diversion and has had proven success implementing this scope of work for
3 other local jurisdictions; and

4 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has determined that the
5 Consulting Agreement provides the best value to the City through an increase in efficiency
6 and a streamline of efforts toward successfully implementing the Senate Bill 1383
7 requirements; and

8 WHEREAS, if the City had to proceed with a formal bid rather than participate
9 in the Consulting Agreement, there would be considerably more funds and time needed for
10 this process; and

11 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
12 follows:

13 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
14 herein by this reference.

15 Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter
16 into an Agreement, and any necessary documents, including any necessary subsequent
17 amendments, with Go2Zero Strategies, LLC, for professional on-call solid waste
18 consulting services on an as-needed basis, on the same terms and conditions afforded in
19 the Consulting Agreement, in a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand
20 Dollars (\$200,000), to be in effect until November 15, 2024, with the option to renew for
21 as long as the Consulting Agreement is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.


22 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
23 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
