Subject: **CODIFYING MECHANISMS REGARDING CLOSING BOATHOUSE LANE**

In response to your request at the May 24, 1994 City Council meeting to report back on the issue of beach and beach parking lot closing hours as they relate to Boathouse Lane, the following information has been prepared for your information.

As you may recall, Mr. Larry Goodhue was concerned that the opening of Boathouse Lane in the new ordinance will be on or before sunrise, which is different than the 5 a.m. opening that the original ordinance provides. The change in the Coastal Commission approved wording states that Boathouse Lane will be open at sunrise, which during the course of a calendar year would be between 4:45 a.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Staff has remedied Mr. Goodhue's concerns by instructing Marine Patrol to open the lot at approximately 5 a.m. each day. In addition, the ordinance does provide for any person attending a permitted activity or concession, such as the Rowing Club, to be allowed access to and from that program or facility.
