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RESOLUTION NO. RES-20-0042

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ORDERING, PROCLAIMING, CALLING, GIVING NOTICE OF AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ON TUESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2020, FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE (3) CITY COUNCILMEMBERS FROM THE SECOND, SIXTH AND EIGHTH COUNCIL DISTRICTS AND FOR ONE (1) LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD MEMBER FROM DISTRICT 2, FOR A FULL TERM OF FOUR (4) YEARS COMMENCING WITH THE THIRD TUESDAY OF DECEMBER, 2020; DESIGNATING THE BALLOT LISTING OF THE CANDIDATES TO BE VOTED ON; AND ADOPTING PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE TRANSLATIONS OF AND THE CHARGES FOR COSTS OF CANDIDATE STATEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution No. RES-19-0159, duly call and provide for the holding of a Primary Nominating Election on Tuesday, March 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Primary Nominating Election was held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, and certain candidates have been nominated for the office of Councilmember for the Second, Sixth and Eighth City Council Districts, and for the Governing Board Member for the Second District of the Long Beach Unified School District; and

1 WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, it is necessary for the City
2 Council to order, proclaim and call a General Municipal Election for the election of
3 Councilmembers for the Second, Sixth and Eighth City Council Districts and for a
4 Governing Board Member for the Second District of the Long Beach Unified School
5 District;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. Pursuant to the Charter of the City of Long Beach and the
9 California Education and Elections Codes, a General Municipal Election is ordered,
10 proclaimed and called to be held in the City of Long Beach, California, between the hours
11 of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on the 3rd day of November, 2020, for the purpose of electing
12 a Member of the City Council for the Second, Sixth and Eighth Council Districts, and for a
13 Governing Board Member for the Second District of the Long Beach Unified School
14 District, for a full term of four (4) years, commencing with the third Tuesday of December,
15 2020.

16 Section 2. The following list of candidates which has been regularly
17 certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the
18 office of Member of the City Council for the Second Council District, and is in the order of
19 the randomized alphabet selected by the Secretary of State:

23 Section 3. The following list of candidates which has been regularly
24 certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the

9 Section 5. The following list of candidates which has been regularly
10 certified by the City Clerk sets forth the candidates nominated as required by law for the
11 office of the Governing Board Member from the Second District of the Long Beach
12 Unified School District, and is in the order of the randomized alphabet selected by the
13 Secretary of State:

18 Section 6. Notice is given of the holding and of the time and place of the
19 election.

20 Section 7. The polls for the General Municipal Election shall be open at
21 7:00 a.m. and shall be kept open until 8:00 p.m. when the polls shall be closed; except
22 that, if at the hour of closing there are any voters in the vote center or in line at the door
23 who are qualified to vote, and who have not been able to do so since appearing, the polls
24 shall be kept open a sufficient time to enable them to vote; but no one who arrives at the
25 polling place after 8:00 p.m. shall be entitled to vote, although the polls may be open
26 when such person arrives.

27 Section 8. California Elections Code Section 13307 requires that a
28 candidate's statement must be translated in Spanish at the candidate's request. Further,

1 in accordance with the requirements of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (PL 94-73)
2 all candidates' statements shall be translated into the languages indicated for Member of
3 the City Council for the Second, Sixth and Eighth Council Districts as follows: Khmer,
4 Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese. A candidate shall not be required to pay for
5 the cost of translating his or her candidate's statement into any foreign language required
6 pursuant to federal and/or state law. However, a candidate shall be required to pay the
7 cost of printing the candidate's statement in the sample ballot pamphlet in the English
8 and/or Spanish language.

9 Section 9. Pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, a
10 charge shall be levied against each candidate for the costs of the candidate's statements
11 sent to each voter. The City Clerk is directed and authorized to establish and implement
12 the charge for the costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing any candidate
13 statements as provided in Elections Code Section 13307. Any allegation of indigency or
14 inability to pay the requisite fee in advance shall be handled by the City Clerk in
15 accordance with the provisions of Elections Code Section 13309.

16 Section 10. The City Clerk shall provide each candidate or the candidate's
17 representative with a copy of the resolution.

18 Section 11. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
19 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
