RECOMMENDATION:

Refer the Proposed Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2017 (FY 17) to the Planning Commission for review of its consistency with the General Plan. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

In accordance with the City Charter, the City Manager has submitted the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for FY 17 to the Mayor, who, in turn, transmitted the document to the City Council. In addition, Article X, Section 1002(e) of the City Charter requires that the Planning Commission review the proposed CIP for consistency with the General Plan. The Planning Commission will then forward its findings to the City Council for consideration.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy Webber on July 13, 2016 and by Budget Analysis Officer Rhutu Amin Gharib on July 18, 2016.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The Planning Commission's findings are required prior to adoption of the FY 17 budget by City Council. This will enable the Commission to meet the necessary timelines for budget consideration.
