FOURTH AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 27276 BETWEEN CITY OF LONG BEACH AND HARBOR BREEZE, INC.

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO PERMIT NO. 27276 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of ____FEB **2 7** 2015 ___, for reference purposes only, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City") and the HARBOR BREEZE, INC., a California corporation ("Permittee"), pursuant to a minute order approved by the City Council of the City of Long Beach on March 3, 2015.

WHEREAS, in 2001 the City Council for the City of Long Beach authorized a Permit to operate in Rainbow Harbor Marina with Permittee for five (5) years with three(3), five-year options upon the mutual consent in writing by the City Manager and Permittee; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2008, the Parties executed the First Amendment to exercise an option and extend the term for additional five years; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2011, the Parties executed the Second Amendment to exercise the remaining options and extend the term for an additional ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2012, the Parties executed the Third Amendment to account for Permittee's acquisition of a new vessel and amortize its cost; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Permit remove or change certain terms of the Permit that have become unnecessary, cost prohibitive and/or would constitute a restated permitted use at Rainbow Harbor Marina:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in the Permit and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2 of Permit No. 27276 is hereby amended by adding section 2.E to read as follows:
 - "2.E. Permittee may sell and operate individually-ticketed cruises, in

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addition to its chartered cruises."

- 2. Section 20 of Permit No. 27276 is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 3. Section 21 of Permit No. 27276 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"21. ASSIGNMENT OR TRANSFER: Permittee shall not assign or transfer this Permit nor shall any interest herein be assignable or transferable by operation of law or by any process or proceedings of any court or otherwise. Any attempted transfer or assignment shall be void and confer no rights whatsoever upon a transferee or assignee.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, each year, for three days preceding the opening of the Long Beach Grand Prix through and including three days following the conclusion of the event, Permittee may temporarily sublet its commercial boat slips to up to ten (10) private boat owners and/or Grand Prix attendees Furthermore, Permittee may grant subpermits, licenses or concessions to others provided Permittee shall first obtain the written consent of the Manager. The Manager shall not be required to give any consent to a proposed subpermitting, licensing or grant of concession rights, unless and until Permittee has submitted to the Manager such additional information regarding the identity of proposed subpermittee, licensee or concessionaire and the terms and conditions of the proposed transaction as may be required by the Manager to make a determination to grant or withhold such consent. Further, the Manager shall have the right to impose such further conditions in connection with the granting of consent as may be required to assure that public health, safety, welfare and convenience will be best served by the proposed sub-permit, license or concession.

If Permittee shall be adjudicated a bankrupt or become insolvent or any interest in this Permit be taken by virtue of attachment, execution, or receivership, the City may terminate this Permit upon five (5) days written notice to Permittee.

4. Except as expressly stated herein, all of the terms, covenants, and conditions of Permit No. 27276 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
