Subject: Application for Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) – Skool Bar, 941 East Fourth Street

The application for an on-sale beer and wine license has been reviewed for Skool Bar, located at 941 East Fourth Street. Due to the high crime in reporting district 282 and residents within 100 feet, I request that the attached conditions be included with the ABC license.

The applicant has been notified and agrees to accept these conditions.

**Requested Alcoholic Beverage License Conditions
An Original Application for
Skool Bar
for an On-Sale Beer and Wine for a public premises license
at 941 East Fourth Street**

Due to being in a high crime reporting distinct, and residences within 100 feet, it is requested that the following conditions be applied:

1. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee, not licensed by ABC for such sales.
2. All beverages offered for sale at the premises shall be displayed and available for convenient inspection and purchase within the premises by the general public.
3. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premise over which they have control.
4. Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
5. To prevent loitering and other criminal activities exterior payphones are prohibited.
6. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent loitering of persons about the premises.
7. A single jukebox or stereo may be maintained on the premises; however, the music shall not be audible outside the premises.
8. During business hours the petitioner(s) shall provide security personnel and shall maintain order therein and prevent any activity, which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby residents. Said personnel shall be clothed in such a manner as to be readily identifiable as security.

Licensee shall not offer or permit or provide any type of live entertainment except as allowed by a valid Entertainment Permit issued by the City of Long Beach.
