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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT
6 36105 WITH MCNEILUS FINANCIAL, INC., DBA MCNEILUS
7 TRUCK AND MANUFACTURING, FOR PROVIDING
8 MCNEILUS BRAND TRUCK PARTS TO INCREASE THE
9 CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$115,000 FOR A REVISED
10 ANNUAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$215,000, WITH A 15
11 PERCENT CONTINGENCY OF \$32,250, FOR A TOTAL
12 ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$247,250
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14 WHEREAS, the City and McNeilus Financial Inc., dba McNeilus Truck &
15 Manufacturing entered into Contract No. 36015 (“Contract”) for the purchase of McNeilus
16 truck parts for City’s existing truck fleet in an annual amount of \$100,000 for a period of
17 two years, with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods, pursuant to the
18 authority provided by Resolution No. RES-21-0043;

19 WHEREAS; additional appropriation is needed due to a market-wide
20 increase in all parts prices, as well as increased need for parts for aging refuse fleet. The
21 ten McNeilus refuse trucks in the existing fleet are used on various routes throughout the
22 City of Long beach and are 12-13 years old and need more frequent repairs due to age;

23 WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an amendment to Contract 36015
24 with McNeilus Financial, Inc. dba McNeilus Truck & Manufacturing (McNeilus) to provide
25 McNeilus brand truck parts by increasing the Contract by \$115,000 for a revised annual
26 contract amount of \$215,000, with a 15% contingency of \$32,250, for a total annual amount
27 not to exceed \$247,250 to be added to the first year term and each subsequent year
28 thereafter;

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WHEREAS; McNeilus Financial Inc., dba McNeilus Truck & Manufacturing is the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) for the City's McNeilus branded refuse trucks and the only provider of these parts which are specialized and unique to McNeilus' proprietary design. Access and use of OEM parts are not only important in keeping critical refuse equipment in operation, but also maintaining warranties, which save the City money. Additional funds are being requested to continue maintaining these City assets at the manufacturer's recommended level of performance; and

WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. 36105 with McNeilus Financial Inc., dba McNeilus Truck & Manufacturing for providing McNeilus brand truck parts, to increase the contract amount by \$115,000 for a revised annual contract amount of \$215,000, with a 15 percent contingency of \$32,250, for a total annual amount not to exceed \$247,250. The parties may, by mutual agreement, extend the term for three (3) additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager. The additional funds of \$115,000 will be added to the first year term starting December 6, 2021, and each subsequent year thereafter.
