A "Digital City" or "Digital Community" refers to a municipality that seeks to proactively engage in efforts that will facilitate a more skilled workforce and partner with the business and creative communities to help incubate more business and job creation.

Long Beach is currently working on numerous digital innovations, including potential participation in a new Google Pilot project and utilization of Public Education Governmental (PEG) funds to support the creation of Digital Academies to train youth at our recreation centers. Long Beach is also home to a burgeoning digital arts community which includes graphic arts and animation. These homegrown industries provide quality jobs, help grow our tax base, and increase the amount of creative industry located in Long Beach.

Long Beach should identify and forward efforts that help create more digital industry in this city. Through the input and identification of key stakeholders and incubators, the City of Long Beach has the potential to become a "Digital City" and help germinate the skill base and municipal planning support necessary to enhance our local economy. The City Manager, in an effort to further discuss and facilitate this, is requested to convene a study session of the City Council and stakeholders, including the digital arts community, to discuss the components of a "Digital City" and how best Long Beach can capture the opportunity to secure a more advanced workforce and support and facilitate the digital creative industry which will lead to more job creation.
