RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation to receive supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing, declare ordinance relating to the temporary limitation (moratorium) on the approval of permits for the installation of wireless telecommunications facilities in the Residential and Institutional zones of the City read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading; declaring the urgency thereof and declaring that this ordinance shall take effect immediately. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

On May 18, 2010 and July 6, 2010, the City Council adopted ordinances which initiated a moratorium on the approval of applications to construct, modify or place wireless communication facilities in the City of Long Beach; and requested the City Attorney, in cooperation with the Development Services Department, to prepare an interim zoning ordinance for notice and placement on the City Council agenda. The moratorium was initiated pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 21.50 of the Municipal Code, "Interim Prohibition of Uses."

The moratoriums are set to expire on September 15, 2010, and November 4, 2010, respectively. Additional time is required to work with local residents and wireless representatives in the telecommunications industry and to study and complete comprehensive regulations for the permitting, placement, design and maintenance of wireless facilities in all zones within the City. The attached ordinance will extend both moratoriums instituted under the ordinances to December 14, 2010.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN INTERIM ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING ORDINANCE
NOS. ORD-10-0015 AND ORD-10-0020 RELATING TO THE
TEMPORARY LIMITATION ON THE ISSUANCE OF
DISCRETIONARY PERMITS FOR THE INSTALLATION,
MODIFICATION OR RELOCATION OF WIRELESS
FACILITIES WITHIN RESIDENTIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL
USE ZONES, RESPECTIVELY; DECLARING THE
URGENCY THEREOF; AND DECLARING THAT THIS
ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2010, by Ordinance No. ORD-10-0015, the City Council of the City of Long Beach imposed, on an urgency basis, a temporary moratorium for one hundred twenty (120) days on the issuance of discretionary permits for the installation, modification or relocation of Wireless Facilities within those areas of the City zoned exclusively for Residential use; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2010, by Ordinance No. ORD-10-0020, the City Council of the City of Long Beach imposed, on an urgency basis, a temporary moratorium for one hundred twenty (120) days on the issuance of discretionary permits for the installation, modification or relocation of Wireless Facilities within those areas of the City zoned exclusively for Institutional use; and

WHEREAS, additional time is required to study and complete the comprehensive regulations for the permitting, placement, design and maintenance of wireless facilities in all zones within the City, and to work with local residents and wireless representatives in the telecommunications industry to review and make revisions to the draft ordinance; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing was held on September 14, 2010, regarding the extension of the moratoriums;

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection F of Section 1 of Ordinance No. ORD-10-0015, adopted May 18, 2010, is amended to read as follows:

F. To accomplish this, the City Council intends to impose, on an urgency basis, a temporary moratorium on the issuance of discretionary permits for the installation, modification or relocation of Wireless Facilities within those areas of the City zoned exclusively for residential use so that City staff, the City Council, and the citizens of the City will have sufficient time to consider a comprehensive ordinance lawfully regulating the installation, modification and relocation of Wireless Facilities in the City. The preparation of such an ordinance, together with the necessary public outreach, legal research, and City processes for consideration of such enactments cannot be completed until December 14, 2010.

Section 2. Section 10 of Ordinance No. ORD-10-0015, adopted May 18, 2010, is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage. It shall be of no further force or effect after December 14, 2010, unless extended following a public hearing, as provided for by law.

- Section 3. Subsection F of Section 1 of Ordinance No. ORD-10-0020, adopted July 6, 2010, is amended to read as follows:
 - F. To accomplish this, the City Council intends to

impose, on an urgency basis, a temporary moratorium on the issuance of discretionary permits for the installation, modification or relocation of Wireless Facilities within those areas of the City zoned exclusively for Institutional use so that City staff, the City Council, and the citizens of the City will have sufficient time to consider a comprehensive ordinance lawfully regulating the installation, modification and relocation of Wireless Facilities in the City's Institutional Zones. The preparation of such an ordinance, together with the necessary public outreach, legal research, and City processes for consideration of such enactments cannot be completed until December 14, 2010.

Section 4. Section 10 of Ordinance No. ORD-10-0020, adopted July 6, 2010, is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage. It shall be of no further force or effect after December 14, 2010, unless extended following a public hearing, as provided for by law.

Section 5. Declaration of Urgency. This ordinance is an emergency measure, and it is urgently required for the reason that, pending completion of the necessary planning study, and a determination relative to the potential need to amend the Zoning or Building regulations of the City, it is necessary to temporarily prohibit the issuance of discretionary permits for the installation, modification or relocation of Wireless Facilities in Residential and Institutional zones of the City that might be inconsistent with the pending revisions to the Zoning or Building regulations of the City being considered during the interim period.

This ordinance is an emergency ordinance duly adopted by Section 6. the City Council on , 2010, by a vote of at least five (5) of its

members and shall take effect immediately. The City Clerk shall certify to a separate roll call and vote on the question of the emergency of this ordinance and to its passage by the vote of five members of the City Council of the City of Long Beach, and cause the same to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.

Section 7. This ordinance shall also be adopted by the City Council as a regular ordinance, to the end that in the event of any defect or invalidity in connection with the adoption of this ordinance as an emergency ordinance, the same shall, nevertheless, be and become effective on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the Mayor.

Section 8. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council of the City of Long Beach and shall cause the same to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.
