RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the Permit, with or without conditions, or deny the Permit on the application of Long Beach Police Athletic League, for a one year boxing/wrestling/karate permit at 1401 W. 9th Street. (District 1)

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code (L.B.M.C.) Chapter 5.24, no person shall operate any professional or amateur boxing/wrestling contests or exhibitions in the City without first having made an application to, and received a permit from, the City Council to do so. The written application shall set forth the exact location and manner in which the contests or exhibitions are to be conducted, the names and addresses of all businesses and persons connected with the contests or exhibitions management, whether the contests or exhibitions are professional or amateur in nature, and the amount of admission to be charged, if any.

All such applications shall be presented to the City Council. If the City Council finds that the conduct of the business will comport with public health, safety, morals and welfare, it may authorize the Director of Financial Management to issue the permit.

The proposed boxing, wrestling and karate events will be held in conjunction with the Youth After School Program, provided at 1401 W. 9th Street, and are scheduled Monday through Sunday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. Admission for the events is \$5.00 per person.

Attached for your review is the application for the Long Beach Police Athletic League, along with various departmental reports. The following information summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit be approved with the attached conditions dated February 6, 2007.
- The Fire Department finds that the building and location meet department requirements for the proposed use.

- The Planning and Building Department finds that the building and location meet department requirements for the proposed use. The Zoning District is IP (Port-Related Industrial).
- The Health and Human Services Department finds the building and location meet department requirements for the proposed use.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on May 23, 2007.



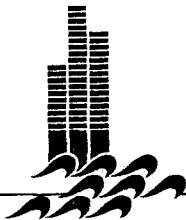

Subject: **APPLICATION FOR BOXING PERMIT – 1401 WEST 9TH STREET**

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Boxing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following twelve (12) conditions of operation:

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) The State Athletic Commission shall have jurisdiction over all professional and amateur boxing, professional and amateur kickboxing, all forms and combinations of full contact martial arts contests, including mixed martial arts, and matches or exhibitions conducted, held, or given within California. (California Business & Professions Code § 18640)
- 3) For amateur boxing, wrestling and full contact martial arts, the State Athletic Commission may authorize a non-profit club or organization to sanction a contest or show. (California Business & Professions Code §18646 (a) (b))
- 4) All USA amateur boxing competitions shall be conducted in accordance with USA Boxing rules and United States Olympic Committee (USOC) requirements. All international competitions shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the International Boxing Association (AIBA) and USA Boxing.
 - a) All participating members, boxers, coaches, assistant coaches, officials, physicians, administrators, clerks, inspectors, must be registered with USA Boxing.
 - b) All boxers must use USA Boxing approved equipment.
 - c) The boxing ring must conform to USA Boxing regulations.

- 5) Any amateur wrestling competition shall be conducted in accordance with an authorized and recognized wrestling association.
- 6) Any amateur martial arts competition shall be conducted in accordance with an authorized and recognized karate association.
- 7) The permittee shall employ his/her own discretion in determining the level of security necessary to prevent violations of law and any other disturbances arising out of or in connection with business operations.
- 8) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting spectators and competitors walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 9) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- 10) Long Beach PAL, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter, such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter. The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses and phone numbers, on file at all times, and must be available for inspection at anytime.
- 11) All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all activities at the location, including those conducted by promoters. The permittee must also supply any hired promoter with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
- 12) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit and any applicable law or ordinance, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

The Zoning Division of the Department of Planning and Building has the following comments:

The Long Beach Police Department has applied for official approval of a boxing permit, through its Police Athletic League program. The subject site is located at 1401 W. 9th Street, in an Industrial zone. The surrounding properties are zoned for Industrial uses. The Long Beach PAL program was incorporated in April of 1991. Therefore, the current facility, which consists of two (2) offices, locker rooms, bathrooms, a storage area, weightlifting area, boxing ring, basketball court, and classroom, is a legally nonconforming use. The Long Beach Pal organization has been hosting boxing tournaments since 1992. During these events, the demand for extra parking is sufficiently accommodated with the availability of three (3) separate parking lots adjacent to the facility. Since the subject site has a legally nonconforming use and the availability of extra parking when needed, staff recommends approval of the proposed boxing permit.
