3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING THE RESULTS OF  
5 THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY  
6 OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, ON TUESDAY,  
7 NOVEMBER 8, 2022, TO SUBMIT TO A VOTE OF THE  
8 QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY FOUR CHARTER  
9 AMENDMENT BALLOT MEASURES

11 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach did, by Resolution  
12 Nos. RES-22-0136, RES-22-0137, RES-22-0138, RES-22-0139, and RES-22-0140, duly  
13 call and provide for the holding of a General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 8,  
14 2022, to submit to a vote of the qualified electors of the City four (4) Charter Amendment  
15 ballot measures; and

16 WHEREAS, the General Municipal Election was held in the City of Long  
17 Beach on Tuesday, November 8, 2022; and

18 WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Registrar duly canvassed the returns of  
19 the election and has transmitted the results to the Long Beach City Clerk;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
21 follows:

22 Section 1. A true and correct copy of the canvass of the votes cast for and  
23 against the Charter Amendment ballot measures is attached as Exhibit "A" to this  
24 Resolution.

25 Section 2. The Charter Amendment ballot measures appeared on the  
26 ballot as follows:

27 A. Measure LBC: Shall the City Charter of Long Beach be  
28 amended to realign the City's primary and general election dates with the

1 State's primary and general election dates held in even-numbered years, and  
2 make other related and technical changes to City election procedures?

3 B. Measure E: Shall the Long Beach City Charter be  
4 amended to establish a Police Oversight Commission and add a Police  
5 Oversight Director, to redesign City's police oversight and accountability  
6 through modified practices, including a Director with authority to audit Police  
7 Department complaint investigations, review major use of force incidents,  
8 and make recommendations on Police Department operations, policies,  
9 procedures, and trainings, and a Commission to provide feedback to the  
10 Director, and which would replace the Citizen Police Complaint Commission?

11 C. Measure BB: Long Beach Water and Gas  
12 Consolidation. Shall the City Charter be amended to merge the existing  
13 water, sewer, and gas utilities into a single publicly-owned utility, governed  
14 by the existing independent Water/Utility Commission; eliminate duplicative  
15 costs by consolidating like operations, improve customer service efficiency  
16 with increased flexibility in sharing of staffing/equipment, reduce impacts to  
17 streets through coordinated utility pipeline street repairs; and achieve cost  
18 savings through greater economies of scale?

19 D. Measure LBU: Realign Long Beach Unified School  
20 District and State Election Dates. Shall the City Charter of Long Beach be  
21 amended to realign the Long Beach Unified School District's primary and  
22 general election dates with the State's primary and general election dates  
23 held in even-numbered years, and make other related and technical changes  
24 to Long Beach Unified School District election procedures?

25 Section 3. It is determined and declared that at the General Municipal  
26 Election, 80,644 votes were cast in favor of Measure LBC and 26,307 votes were cast  
27 against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is  
28 hereby approved.

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Section 4. It is determined and declared that at the General Municipal Election, 64,494 votes were cast in favor of Measure E and 43,427 votes were cast against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is hereby approved.

Section 5. It is determined and declared that at the General Municipal Election, 68,557 votes were cast in favor of Measure BB and 38,707 votes were cast against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is hereby approved.

Section 6. It is determined and declared that at the General Municipal Election, 89,106 votes were cast in favor of Measure LBU and 32,289 votes were cast against it, and that it received a majority of the votes cast and that such proposition is hereby approved.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
