Recommendation for June 5, 2018 Ballot Initiative Argument Writers

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution providing for the filing of primary and rebuttal arguments and setting rules for the filing of written arguments regarding a City Charter Amendment measure to be submitted at the June 5, 2018 General Municipal Election. (Citywide)

#### DISCUSSION:

On March 7, 2018, the City Council passed a resolution putting a Charter Amendment on the June 5, 2018 ballot regarding the transfer of funds from utilities to the City's general fund. As part of the ballot process there needs to be opportunity for primary and rebuttal arguments.

Pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code Section 1.24.020, I designate the following people to write primary arguments:

For the City Measure:

Robert Garcia, Mayor, Michael Duree, Fire Chief, and

Robert Luna, Police Chief

Against the City Measure:

Diana Lejins, Taxpayers Rights Advocate, E. Gerrie

Schipske, Attorney, Thomas Stout Long Beach Taxpayers

Association, and Joseph Weinstein, CARP

If the four against the measure cannot agree upon a statement Mr. Stout from Long Beach Taxpayers Association will be the lead author and have final

authority over the written argument.

### **TIMING CONSIDERATIONS:**

City Council action is recommended on March 13, 2018 to meet the requirements mandated by the California Elections and Government Codes for placing a Charter Amendment on the June 5, 2018 ballot.
