RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached resolution and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all necessary documents to receive and expend grant funding from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control 2014 grant, and increase appropriations in the General Grants Fund (SR 120) in the Police Department (PD) by \$50,000. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

On May 16, 2014, the Long Beach Police Department was awarded grant funding for the third consecutive year from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control 2014/2015 (ABC 14) grant in the amount of \$50,000. The grant monies will be used for overtime, investigative services, and training to identify and focus on problematic ABC licensed establishments, and to ensure compliance with City and State laws to improve public safety and solve neighborhood problems.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Kendra Carney on June 16, 2014 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 17, 2014.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on July 22, 2014, to expedite use of the grant funds.

FISCAL IMPACT

The ABC 14 grant is currently unbudgeted; an appropriation increase is requested in the General Grants Fund (SR 120) in the Police Department (PD) in the amount of \$50,000. Grant revenues will offset the expense appropriation and the grant does not require matching funds. There is no local job impact associated with the recommended action.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL FOR GRANT FUNDING

WHEREAS. THE CITY OF LONG BEACH desires to undertake a certain project designated as "ABC Investigations" to be funded in part from funds made available through the Grant Assistance Program (GAP) administered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (hereafter referred to as ABC);

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

That the City Manager of the City of Long Beach is authorized Section 1. to execute on behalf of the City Council the State Contract, including any extensions or amendments thereof and any subsequent contract with the State in relation thereto.

Section 2. IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and ABC disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received Section 3. hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

Section 4. IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to local hiring freezes.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
