3rd AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT NO.29078

THIS AMENDMENT to AGREEMENT is made this 17th day of May, 2006, between CITY OF LONG BEACH, called the Contractor, and the LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter called the District.

WITNESSETH

The Contractor and District do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. To amend that certain Agreement 2008.01 entered into on January 10, 2005, to administer 21st Century WRAP after-school program Burbank Elementary School due to extension of California Department of Education (CDE) grant funding:
 - A. By extending the contract completion date from June 30, 2006 to be through December 31, 2006.
 - B. By adding the following condition:

Work shall be performed in accordance with the 21st Century Policies and Procedures Manual that has been issued by the District, incorporated herein by reference.

2. Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of Agreement 2008.01 effective July 1, 2004, shall remain in full force and effect.
