A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT AND ANY NECESSARY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS WITH STRICTLY TECHNOLOGY. LLC FOR PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, PARTS, AND RELATED PRODUCTS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS-USA), IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000, UNTIL THE TIPS-USA CONTRACT EXPIRES ON MAY 31, 2028, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR AS LONG AS THE TIPS-USA CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase computer equipment, parts, and related products; and

WHEREAS, The Interlocal Purchasing System ("TIPS-USA") has a contract with Strictly Technology, LLC for the purchase of these computer equipment, parts, and related products, Contract No. 230105 ("Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract will facilitate the City's ability to purchase, as well as provide, considerable cost

benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than participate in the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter an Section 2. agreement with Strictly Technology, LLC to purchase computer equipment, parts, and related products, of the same type and kind identified in the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Strictly Technology, LLC, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded in the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA contract in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), until the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract expires on May 31, 2028, with the option to renew for as long as the Strictly Technology TIPS-USA Contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
