CARES ACT GRANT AGREEMENT

THIS CARES ACT GRANT AGREEMENT, ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH ("CITY"), a municipal corporation, with its principal place of business at 411 West Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, California 90802, and the GO2ZERO STRATEGIES, LLC, a nonprofit limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of California ("GRANTEE"), with its principal place of business at 6625 N. Calle Eva Miranda, Suite A, Irwindale, California 91702.

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach received a Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) award of \$40,280,000 from the U.S. Treasury, as appropriated in Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Relief Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), P.L. 116-136; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the award to the CITY is to respond to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, payments from the CRF may only be used to cover costs that: (1) are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19; (2) were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government; and (3) were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on March 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the CITY is required by federal law to impose various terms and conditions, including expedited reporting requirements, on the GRANTEE; and

WHEREAS, CITY has selected GRANTEE in accordance with CITY's administrative procedures using a Request for Proposals HE21-018 ("RFP"), incorporated by this reference as if fully set forth herein, and CITY has determined that GRANTEE and its employees are qualified, licensed, if so required, and experienced in performing these specialized services; and
