2 Contractor shall submit requests for progress payments and City will make
3 payments in due course of payments in accordance with Section 9 of the Standard
4 Specifications for Public Works Construction (latest edition).

5 3. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The Contract Documents include: The
6 Notice Inviting Bids, Plans & Specifications No. R-6682 (which may include by reference
7 the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction, latest edition, and any
8 supplements thereto, collectively the "Standard Specifications"); the City of Long Beach
9 Standard Plans; the California Code of Regulations; the various Uniform Codes applicable
10 to trades; the prevailing wage rates; Instructions to Bidders; the Bid; the bid security; the
11 City of Long Beach Disadvantaged, Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprise
12 Program; this Contract and all documents attached hereto or referenced herein including
13 but not limited to insurance; Bond for Faithful Performance; Payment Bond; Notice to
14 Proceed; Notice of Completion; any addenda or change orders issued in accordance with
15 the Standard Specifications; any permits required and issued for the work; approved final
16 design drawings and documents; and the Information Sheet. These Contract Documents
17 are incorporated herein by the above reference and form a part of this Contract.

18 Notwithstanding Section 2-5.2 of the Standard Specifications, if any conflict
19 or inconsistency exists or develops among or between Contract Documents, the following
20 priority shall govern: 1) Change Orders; 2) this Contract; 3) Permit(s) from other public
21 agencies; 4) Plans & Specifications No. R-6682; 5) Addenda; 6) the City of Long Beach
22 Standard Plans; 7) Standard Specifications; 8) other reference specifications; 9) other
23 reference plans; 10) the bid; and 11) the Notice Inviting Bids.

24 4. TIME FOR CONTRACT. Contractor shall commence work on September
25 15, 2005 and shall complete all work by September 14, 2006, subject to strikes, lockouts
26 and events beyond the control of Contractor. Time is of the essence hereunder. City will
27 suffer damage if the work is not completed within the time stated, but those damages
28 would be difficult or impractical to determine. So, Contractor shall pay to City, as liquidated

1 damages, the amount stated in the Contract Documents.

2 5. ACCEPTANCE OF WORK NOT TO CONSTITUTE A WAIVER. The
3 acceptance of any work or the payment of any money by the City shall not operate as a
4 waiver of any provision of any Contract Document, of any power reserved to the City, or
5 of any right to damages or indemnity hereunder. The waiver of any breach or any default
6 hereunder shall not be deemed a waiver of any other or subsequent breach or default.

7 6. WORKERS' COMPENSATION CERTIFICATION. Concurrently herewith,
8 Contractor shall submit certification of Workers' Compensation coverage in accordance
9 with California Labor Code Sections 1860 and 3700, a copy of which is attached hereto as
10 Exhibit "B".

11 7. CLAIMS FOR EXTRA WORK. No claim shall be made at any time upon
12 the City by Contractor for and on account of any extra or additional work performed or
13 materials furnished, unless such extra or additional work or materials shall have been
14 expressly required by the City Manager and the quantities and price thereof shall have
15 been first agreed upon, in writing, by the parties hereto.

16 8. CLAIMS. Contractor shall, upon completion of the work, deliver
17 possession thereof to the City ready for use and free and discharged from all claims for
18 labor and materials in doing the work and shall assume and be responsible for, and shall
19 protect, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City from and against any and all claims,
20 demands, causes of action, liability, loss, costs or expenses for injuries to or death of
21 persons, or damages to property, including property of the City, which arises from or is
22 connected with the performance of the work.

23 9. INSURANCE. Prior to commencement of work, and as a condition
24 precedent to the effectiveness of this Contract, Contractor shall provide to the City
25 evidence of all insurance required in the Contract Documents.

26 In addition, Contractor shall complete and deliver to the City the form
27 ("Information Sheet") attached as Exhibit "C" and incorporated by reference, to comply with
28 Labor Code Section 2810.

1 10. WORK DAY. Contractor shall comply with Sections 1810 through 1815
2 of the California Labor Code regarding hours of work. Contractor shall forfeit, as a penalty
3 to the City, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) for each worker employed by Contractor
4 or any subcontractor for each calendar day such worker is required or permitted to work
5 more than eight (8) hours unless that worker receives compensation in accordance with
6 Section 1815.

7 11. PREVAILING WAGE RATES. Contractor is directed to the prevailing
8 wage rates. Contractor shall forfeit, as a penalty to the City, Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each
9 laborer, worker or mechanic employed for each calendar day, or portion thereof, that such
10 laborer, worker or mechanic is paid less than the prevailing wage rates for any work done
11 by Contractor, or any subcontractor, under this Contract.

12 12. COORDINATION WITH GOVERNMENTAL REGULATIONS. If the work
13 is terminated pursuant to an order of any Federal or State authority, Contractor shall accept
14 as full and complete compensation under this Contract such amount of money as will equal
15 the product of multiplying the Contract price stated herein by the percentage of work
16 completed by Contractor as of the date of such termination, and for which Contractor has
17 not been paid. If the work is so terminated, the City Engineer, after consultation with
18 Contractor, shall determine the percentage of work completed and the determination of the
19 City Engineer shall be final.

20 If Contractor is prevented, in any manner, from strict compliance with the
21 Plans and Specifications due to any Federal or State law, rule, or regulation, in addition to
22 all other rights and remedies reserved to the parties City may by resolution of the City
23 Council suspend performance hereunder until the cause of disability is removed, extend
24 the time for performance, make changes in the character of the work or materials, or
25 terminate this Contract without liability to either party.

26 13. NOTICES. A. Any notice required hereunder shall be in writing and
27 personally delivered or deposited in the U.S. Postal Service, first class, postage prepaid,
28 to Contractor at the address first stated herein, and to the City at 333 West Ocean

1 Boulevard, Long Beach, California 90802, Attn: City Manager. Notice of change of address
2 shall be given in the same manner as stated herein for other notices. Notice shall be
3 deemed given on the date deposited in the mail or on the date personal delivery is made,
4 whichever first occurs.

5 B. Except for stop notices and claims made under the Labor Code, the City
6 will notify Contractor when the City receives any third party claims relating to this Contract
7 in accordance with Section 9201 of the Public Contract Code.

8 14. BONDS. Contractor shall, simultaneously with the execution of this
9 Contract, execute and deliver to the City a good and sufficient corporate surety bond, in
10 the form attached hereto and in the amount specified therein, conditioned upon the faithful
11 performance of this Contract by Contractor, and a good and sufficient corporate surety
12 bond, in the form attached hereto and in the amount specified therein, conditioned upon
13 the payment of all labor and material claims incurred in connection with this Contract.

14 15. COVENANT AGAINST ASSIGNMENT. Neither this Contract nor any
15 of the moneys that may become due Contractor hereunder may be assigned by Contractor
16 without the written consent of the City first had and obtained, nor will the City recognize any
17 subcontractor as such, and all persons engaged in the work of construction will be
18 considered as independent contractors or agents of the Contractor and will be held directly
19 responsible to Contractor.

20 16. CERTIFIED PAYROLL RECORDS. Contractor shall keep and cause
21 each subcontractor to keep an accurate payroll record in accordance with Division 2, Part
22 7, Article 2 of the California Labor Code. Contractor's failure to furnish such record to City
23 in the manner provided herein for notices shall entitle City to withhold the penalty
24 prescribed by law from progress payments due to Contractor.

25 17. RESPONSIBILITY OF CONTRACTOR. Notwithstanding anything to the
26 contrary in the Standard Specifications, Contractor shall have the responsibility, care and
27 custody of the work. If any loss or damage occurs to the work that is not covered by
28 collectible commercial insurance, excluding loss or damage caused by the negligence or

1 willful misconduct of City, earthquake, or flood, then Contractor shall immediately make the
2 City whole for any such loss or pay for any damage. If Contractor fails or refuses to make
3 the City whole or pay, then City may do so and the cost and expense of doing so shall be
4 deducted from the amount due Contractor from City hereunder.

5 18. CONTINUATION. Termination or expiration of this Contract shall not
6 terminate the rights or liabilities of either party which rights or liabilities accrued or existed
7 prior to termination or expiration of this Contract.

8 19. TAXES AND TAX REPORTING. A. As required by federal and state
9 law, City is obligated to report the payment of compensation to Contractor on Form 1099-
10 Misc. and Contractor acknowledges that Contractor is not entitled to payment under this
11 Contract until it has provided its Employer's Identification Number to the City. Contractor
12 shall be solely responsible for payment of all federal and state taxes resulting from
13 payments under this Contract.

14 B. Contractor shall cooperate with the City in all matters relating to taxation
15 and the collection of taxes, particularly with respect to the self-accrual of use tax.
16 Contractor shall cooperate as follows: (i) for all leases and purchases of materials,
17 equipment, supplies, or other tangible personal property totaling over \$100,000 shipped
18 from outside California, a qualified Contractor shall complete and submit to the appropriate
19 governmental entity the form in Appendix "A" attached hereto; and (ii) for construction
20 contracts and subcontracts totaling \$5,000,000 or more, Contractor shall obtain a sub-
21 permit from the California Board of Equalization for the Work site. "Qualified" means that
22 the Contractor purchased at least \$500,000 in tangible personal property that was subject
23 to sales or use tax in the previous calendar year.

24 In completing the form and obtaining the permit(s), Contractor shall use the
25 address of the Work site as its business address and may use any address for its mailing
26 address. Copies of the form and permit(s) shall also be delivered to the City Engineer.
27 The form must be submitted and the permit(s) obtained as soon as Contractor receives a
28 Notice to Proceed. Contractor shall not order any materials or equipment over \$100,000

1 from vendors outside California until the form is submitted and the permit(s) obtained and,
2 if Contractor does so, it shall be a material breach of this Contract. In addition, Contractor
3 shall make all purchases from the Long Beach sales office of its vendors if those vendors
4 have a Long Beach office and all purchases made by Contractor under this Contract which
5 are subject to use tax of \$500,000 or more shall be allocated to the City of Long Beach.
6 Contractor shall require the same form and permit(s) from its subcontractors.

7 Contractor shall not be entitled to and by signing this Contract waives any
8 claim or damages for delay against City if Contractor does not timely submit these forms
9 to the appropriate governmental entity. Contractor may contact the City Controller at (562)
10 570-6450 for assistance with the form.

11 20. ADVERTISING. Contractor shall not use the name of City, its officials,
12 or employees in any advertising or solicitation for business, nor as a reference, without the
13 prior approval of the City Manager, City Engineer, or designee.

14 21. AUDIT. If payment of any part of the consideration for this Contract is
15 made with federal, state, or county funds and a condition to the use of those funds by City
16 is a requirement that the City render an accounting or otherwise account for said funds,
17 then City shall have the right at all reasonable times to examine, audit, inspect, review,
18 extract information from, and copy all books, records, accounts, and other information
19 relating to this Contract.

20 22. NO PECULIAR RISK. Contractor acknowledges and agrees that the
21 work to be performed hereunder does not constitute a peculiar risk of bodily harm and that
22 no special precautions are required to perform said work.

23 23. THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY. This Contract is intended by the parties
24 to benefit themselves only and is not in any way intended or designed to or entered for the
25 purpose of creating any benefit or right of any kind for any person or entity that is not a
26 party to this Contract.

27 24. SUBCONTRACTORS. Contractor agrees to and shall bind every
28 subcontractor to the terms of this Contract provided, however, that nothing herein shall

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1 create any obligation on the part of City to pay any subcontractor except in accordance
2 with a court order in an action to foreclose a stop notice. Failure of Contractor to comply
3 with this Section shall be deemed a material breach of this Contract. A list of
4 subcontractor(s) submitted by Contractor in compliance with Public Contract Code
5 Sections 4100 et seq. is attached hereto as Exhibit "D" and incorporated herein by this
6 reference.

7 25. NO DUTY TO INSPECT. No language in this Contract shall create and
8 City shall not have any duty to inspect, correct, warn of, or investigate any condition arising
9 from Contractor's work hereunder, or to insure compliance with laws, rules or regulations
10 relating to said work. If City does inspect or investigate, the results thereof shall not be
11 deemed compliance with or a waiver of any requirements of the Contract Documents.

12 26. GOVERNING LAW. This Contract shall be governed by and construed
13 pursuant to the laws of the State of California (except those provisions of California law
14 pertaining to conflicts of laws).

15 27. INTEGRATION. This Contract, including the Contract Documents
16 identified in Section 3 hereof, constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and
17 supersedes all other agreements, oral or written, with respect to the subject matter herein.

18 28. COSTS. If there is any legal proceeding between the parties to enforce
19 or interpret this Contract or to protect or establish any rights or remedies hereunder, the
20 prevailing party shall be entitled to its costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's
21 fees.

22 29. NONDISCRIMINATION. In connection with performance of this Contract
23 and subject to federal laws, rules and regulations, Contractor shall not discriminate in
24 employment or in the performance of this Contract on the basis of race, religion, national
25 origin, color, age, sex, sexual orientation, AIDS, HIV status, handicap, or disability. It is the
26 policy of the City to encourage the participation of Disadvantaged, Minority and Women-
27 owned Business Enterprises and the City encourages Contractor to use its best efforts to
28 carry out this policy in the award of all subcontracts.

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30. DEFAULT. Default shall include but not be limited to Contractor's failure to perform in accordance with the Plans and Specifications, failure to comply with any Contract Document, failure to pay any penalties, fines or charges assessed against the Contractor by any public agency, failure to pay any charges or fees for services performed by the City, and if Contractor has substituted any security in lieu of retention, then default shall also include City's receipt of a stop notice. If default occurs and Contractor has substituted any security in lieu of retention, then in addition to City's other legal remedies, City shall have the right to draw on the security in accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300 and without further notice to Contractor. If default occurs and Contractor has not substituted any security in lieu of retention, then City shall have all legal remedies available to it.
