## ORDINANCE NO. ORD-13-0009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 10.32.110 RELATING TO PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT "AB"

WHEREAS, residents of Kallin Avenue between 9<sup>th</sup> Street and 11<sup>th</sup> Street,
E. Studebaker Road between Almada Street and Mantova Street, 11<sup>th</sup> Street between
Kallin Avenue and a point 335 feet east of Kallin Avenue have requested to be included in Preferential Parking District AB to seek on-street parking relief due to overflow parking generated by California State University students; and

WHEREAS, a parking study conducted during a peak period of activity at Kallin Avenue revealed that eighty-nine percent (89%) of the existing on-street parking spaces within a two block area were occupied at the time of the study; and

WHEREAS, eighty-seven percent (87%) of the vehicles parked on the two blocks were not registered to residents of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, a petition formally requesting the establishment of a preferential parking district and a one-hour parking restriction from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday was circulated among the residents of the two block area; and

WHEREAS, a review of the petition revealed that eighty-three percent (83%) of the residents of Kallin Avenue and one hundred percent (100%) of the residents of Studebaker Road and the segment of 11<sup>th</sup> Street supported the implementation of preferential parking and the proposed parking restriction; and

WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has reviewed the results of the parking study and the resident petition and he has determined that conditions meet minimum Municipal Code criteria as outlined in LBMC 10.32.020 for the consideration of a Preferential Parking District;

Section 1. District "AB" of Section 10.32.110 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

District AB: North side of Anaheim Road between Studebaker Road and El Jardin Street; both sides of Anaheim Road between El Jardin Street and Almada Street; both sides of El Jardin Street between Studebaker Road and Anaheim Road; both sides of 11th Street between Kallin Avenue and Stevely Avenue; both sides of 10th Street between Kallin Avenue and Stevely Avenue; both sides of 9th Street between Studebaker Road and Roxanne Avenue; west side of Kallin Avenue between 9th Street and a point 95 feet north of 9th Street; east side Kallin Avenue between 9th Street and Anaheim Road; both sides of Almada Street between Studebaker Road and Anaheim Road; both sides E. Studebaker Road (service road), between El Jardin Street and Deleon Street; and both sides of Mantova Street between Studebaker Road.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
