3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH RECOGNIZING OCTOBER AS  
5 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MONTH

7 WHEREAS, National Pedestrian Safety Month is recognized annually  
8 during the month of October and aims to increase awareness around pedestrian safety  
9 and advocates for a safer environment for all roadway users; and

10 WHEREAS, National Pedestrian Safety month further recognizes that  
11 transport is important to society and that travel should be safe for all road users, and  
12 reminds us that pedestrian collisions, like all road traffic crashes, should not be accepted  
13 as inevitable; and

14 WHEREAS, in 2016, the Long Beach City Council committed to a Vision  
15 Zero goal to eliminate traffic deaths and serious injuries by 2026; and

16 WHEREAS, in July 2020, the Safe Streets Long Beach Action Plan was  
17 adopted and outlined a plan to eliminate traffic-related deaths and serious injuries  
18 citywide; and

19 WHEREAS, according to the Safe Streets Long Beach Action Plan, 35% of  
20 serious injury crash victims are pedestrians; and

21 WHEREAS, it is clear that in order to protect pedestrians and promote safe  
22 walking, there must be awareness of the dangers of the roadways; and

23 WHEREAS, pedestrian safety measures improve walking environments and  
24 contribute to urban renewal, economic growth, social cohesion, improved air quality, and  
25 reduction of traffic noise; and

26 WHEREAS, by supporting National Pedestrian Safety Month by similarly  
27 declaring October as the City of Long Beach's Pedestrian Safety Month, the City will  
28 continue to ensure its commitment to its Vision Zero goal set in 2016;
