Delgado is an award winning public relations professional and journalist with over 15 years of experience in the areas of public affairs, public relations, media relations and crisis and issues management.

Delgado has been in the trenches of complicated public affairs and public relations campaigns for a wide range of entities in the private, government, and non-profit sector.

Prior to becoming Region Manager of Public Affairs for Southern California Edison, she served as the West Region Communications and Public Affairs Director for the Coca-Cola Company, North America Group where she was responsible for internal and external communications for the West Region, including So.
