RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract with Dooley Enterprises, Inc., of Anaheim, CA, for furnishing and delivering Winchester ammunition without advertising for bids, in an annual amount not to exceed \$400,000, for a period of two years, with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods, at the discretion of the City Manager. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

City Council approval is requested for the Long Beach Police Department (LBPDP) to enter into a contract with Dooley Enterprises, Inc., to purchase ammunition manufactured by Winchester for training and shooting qualification requirements for LBPDP armed personnel. Dooley Enterprises, Inc., is the sole authorized distributor in California that supplies Winchester ammunition.

LBPDP has standardized its training rounds and premium duty rounds with Winchester factory-loaded ammunitions since 2004. Winchester goes to great lengths to ensure its training and duty rounds are identical. Standardization is necessary when handling a lethal weapon where performance and accuracy are critical.

City Charter Section 1801 requires that contracts for City purchases be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after a competitive bid process, but allows for awards without a competitive bid process if accompanied by a Resolution adopted by City Council.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Monica J. Kilaita on June 28, 2018 and by Budget Management Officer Rhutu Amin Gharib on July 6, 2018.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on August 7, 2018, to ensure the contract is in place expeditiously.

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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH DOOLEY ENTERPRISES, INC. WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR FURNISHING AND DELIVERING WINCHESTER AMMUNITION FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000

WHEREAS, the City requires ammunition manufactured by Winchester for training and shooting qualification requirements for LBPD armed personnel; and

WHEREAS, LBPD has standardized its training rounds and premium duty rounds with Winchester factory-loaded ammunitions since 2004; and

WHEREAS, Dooley Enterprises, Inc. is the sole authorized distributor in California that supplies Winchester ammunition; and

WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids for furnishing and delivering this type of ammunition and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds because Dooley Enterprises, Inc. is the only corporation, firm or individual that could or would bid for the furnishing of Winchester factory-loaded ammunition to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

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Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract and any amendments thereto with Dooley Enterprises, Inc. for furnishing and delivering Winchester ammunition in an annual amount not to exceed Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000), for a period of two years, with the option to renew for three additional one-year periods.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
