SUBJECT: REPORT ON RESULTS OF 1% MANUAL TALLY

Pursuant to Cal. E.C. 15360(e), this report is provided to you as a part of the official canvass of the May 1, 2007, Special Municipal Election.

On Friday, May 18, 2007, two boards conducted the required 1% manual tally on precincts 3850145B (BT2), and 3850254A (BT1). Changes from the manual tally are noted on the attached precinct reports. Reasons for discrepancies are noted below. Resolutions of the discrepancies are summarized (by hand markings) on the attached report.

Board #1, who tallied 3850254A (CD3), experienced a discrepancy in one ballot affecting Proposition B. The hand count resulted in one less "yes" vote and an additional "no" vote. Total votes for Proposition B are 51-yes, and 207-no. Total ballots cast were unchanged at 258. This does not change the results.

Board #1 also noted a discrepancy in the total votes cast for Proposition G. The hand count of the number of "no" votes resulted in 55 rather than the 56 counted by the voting system. Total votes cast changed from 255 to 254. This does not change the results.

Board #2, who tallied 3850145B (CD6), had a discrepancy in how three ballots were tabulated by the voting system v. the manual tally. Votes cast directly for the candidates were unchanged. This discrepancy is the result of how the ballots were resolved on election night v. the interpretation by the tally board. There was no discrepancy in the total number of ballots cast, which was 180. This does not change the results.
