Subject: school issues with parking

As a resident (2483 Eucalyptus) we are subject to major traffic disruptions twice a day - dismissal in the afternoon being the worst. Eucalyptus is a standard width residential street allowing for cars to be parked along either curb (opposite sides of the street) with room for cars to travel in both directions. The street does become one-way (North bound only) during drop-off and pick up hours meaning that vehicles can only drive in one direction (North). What happens at dismissal is that earlier arriving parents picking up their children will park curbside (both sides of the street) and then parents arriving later will create a second line heading north (illegally double parking). People coming South disregard the one way causing a road block as now there is only one clear lane for vehicles to use on Eucalyptus. Parents wanting to leave are either trapped at either curb or behind another vehicle waiting in line to pick up their children."
