8 UNREPRESENTED MANAGEMENT MISCELLANEOUS
9 EMPLOYEES, THE CITY ATTORNEY, CITY PROSECUTOR,
10 CITY AUDITOR, CITY MANAGER, CITY CLERK AND
11 MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY THE
12 LONG BEACH MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION TO THE
13 CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM
14 (CalPERS)

16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
17 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or
19 agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid
20 by the employer, and reported as special compensation; and

21 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section
22 is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving
23 notice of its intention to commence paying and reporting the value of employer paid
24 member contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class
25 as identified herein.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
27 as follows:

28 Section 1. Effective as of July 22, 2006, the governing body of the City of



1 Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to
2 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member
3 Contributions (EPMC) for all unrepresented management miscellaneous employees
4 paid pursuant to Executive Salary Rates (EOO) of the City's Salary Schedule and the
5 City Attorney, City Auditor, City Prosecutor, City Manager, City Clerk and miscellaneous
6 employees represented by the Long Beach Management Association. This benefit
7 shall consist of the City paying 7% of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting
8 the same percent value of compensation earnable, excluding special compensation
9 pursuant to Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The
10 employee shall pay 1% of the normal contribution. Effective January 6, 2007, this
11 benefit shall consist of the City paying 6% and the employee paying 2%.

12 Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
13 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
