RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution designating the City of Long Beach (City) as the Administering Agency and Signatory Authority for Workforce Investment Act Programs and designating the Workforce Investment Board to provide policy guidance and oversight for the cities of Long Beach, Signal Hill, Lomita and Torrance. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

Through acceptance of federal Workforce Investment Act funds on behalf of the residents and businesses of Long Beach, Signal Hill, Lomita, and Torrance, the City serves as administrative entity on behalf of the local workforce investment area. Prior to releasing grant funds to the workforce area, the State requires a resolution by the City designating the Workforce Development Bureau as Administering Agency, and the Workforce Investment Board as the policy and guidance entity for the consortium.

This letter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Gary J. Anderson on May 21, 2007 and Budget and Performance Management Manager David Wodynski on June 7, 2007.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on June 19, 2007 to facilitate processing of required documents.

FISCAL IMPACT


Sufficient funds are currently appropriated in the Community Development Grants Fund (SR 150) in the Department of Community Development (CD). There is no impact to the General Fund.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DESIGNATING THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AS THE ADMINISTERING AGENCY AND SIGNATORY AUTHORITY FOR THE LOCAL WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT PROGRAMS AND DESIGNATING THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD TO PROVIDE POLICY GUIDANCE AND OVERSIGHT FOR THE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has received notification of a formula allocation of \$5,202,098.00 from the State of California, Employment Development Department ("State"), to provide workforce development services for residents and businesses (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, in order to participate in the Program the State requires that a resolution of the City Council be adopted which designates the administering agency and signatory authority for the Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City of Long Beach shall be the administering agency and signatory authority for the Program.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Long Beach designates the Workforce Investment Board to provide policy guidance and oversight for the Program.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Long Beach acknowledges that the City shall be responsible to the State of California, Employment Development Department, for the expenditure of all funds and liable for those funds not expended in accordance with the Program, and shall return such funds to the State of California,

2 Section 4. The City Council of the City of Long Beach authorizes the City
3 Manager or his designee to execute all documents necessary for the implementation of
4 the Program, including, but not limited to, plans, modifications, adjustments, grant
5 applications, grants, subgrant agreements, and other contracts.

6 Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
7 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this Resolution.
