## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached continuous resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for the First Cycle Used Oil Payment Program (OPP) and to execute all necessary documents related thereto. (Citywide)

## DISCUSSION

The California Department of Resource Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB), provides a payment program to local jurisdictions to promote the collection and recycling of used motor oil and used motor oil filters. This will be the City's first Oil Payment Program funding. The City previously received funding under the CIWMB's Used Motor Oil Block Grant.

CalRecycle requires a resolution of the City Council authorizing the grant application. The resolution also authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute all necessary documents to carry out the purposes of the grant received.

The State of California allocates funds to each jurisdiction annually. The grant period runs from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012. Grant amounts are calculated on a per capita basis from a fund of about \$11 million dollars.

The City will use these funds to promote used oil recycling through various advertising and media outlets such as newspaper advertisements, video productions, brochures, refuse truck signs and unique giveaways distributed at Citywide events.

This letter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy Burton on June 14, 2010 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 15, 2010.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested by July 6, 2010 in order to submit the grant application to CalRecycle before the July 30, 2010 deadline.


FISCAL IMPACT

The City of Long Beach will receive approximately \$132,000 to continue to fund used motor oil recycling activities. The exact amount will not be known until August 2010. Sufficient appropriation is currently budgeted and grant funds will be deposited in the Refuse/Recycling Fund (EF 330) in the Department of Public Works (PW). Matching funds are not required. The OPP will have no impact on local jobs.

Approve recommendation.



3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO APPLY FOR THE FIRST CYCLE USED OIL

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code § 48690, the Department  
9 of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California  
10 Integrated Waste Management Board, has established the Used Oil Payment Program  
11 (OPP) to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions for implementation of their used oil  
12 programs; and

13 WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to  
14 establish procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and

15 WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil  
16 Payment Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare  
17 by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Used Oil Payment  
18 Program;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
20 follows:

21 Section 1. The City Council authorizes the submittal of a Used Oil  
22 Payment Program application to CalRecycle.

23 Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and  
24 empowered to execute in the name of the City of Long Beach all documents, including  
25 but not limited to, applications, agreements, annual reports including expenditure reports  
26 and amendments necessary to secure said payments to support the Used Oil Collection  
27 Program.

28 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption

1 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
