RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0060

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE GENERAL PLAN
OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH BY ADOPTING AN
HISTORIC PRESERVATION ELEMENT

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find, determine and declare:

A. The City Council desires to amend the General Plan of the City of Long Beach by adopting an Historic Preservation Element as set forth in this resolution.

B. The Planning Commission held a public hearing on April 15, 2010, regarding the adoption of an Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan.

C. At that hearing, the Planning Commission gave full consideration to all pertinent facts, information, proposals, environmental documentation and recommendations respecting all parts of an Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan and the viewpoints expressed at the public hearing, and afforded full opportunity for public input and participation.

D. Following receipt of all appropriate environmental documentation, full hearings and deliberation, the City Planning Commission certified Negative Declaration No. ND-14-09 on April 15, 2010, and recommended approval of an Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan of the City of Long Beach and further directed that said

1 recommendation be forwarded to the City Council for consideration.

2 E. That on May 18, 2010, the City Council conducted a duly
3 noticed public hearing at which it gave full consideration to all pertinent
4 facts, information, proposals, environmental documentation and
5 recommendations respecting all parts of an Historic Preservation Element
6 of the General Plan and the views expressed at the public hearing and
7 afforded full opportunity for public input and participation.

8 F. Following receipt of all appropriate environmental
9 documentation, full hearings and deliberation, the City Council did concur
10 with the recommendations of the Planning Commission and approved and
11 adopted the environmental documentation and an Historic Preservation
12 Element of the General Plan of the City of Long Beach

13 Section 2. The City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby formally
14 approves and adopts an Historic Preservation Element of the General Plan of the City of
15 Long Beach, as recommended by the Planning Commission. Such Historic Preservation
16 Element is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

17 Section 3. The Director of Development Services for the City of Long
18 Beach shall promptly submit a copy of the adopted Historic Preservation Element to the
19 State Department of Housing and Community Development in accordance with
20 Government Code Section 65585(g).

21 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

23 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City


