APRIL AS DOLORES HUERTA DAY, A DAY OF
CELEBRATION IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH

WHEREAS, Dolores Huerta is recognized as an influential person for her leadership and many contributions to her community; and

WHEREAS, Huerta had many contributions to the Mexican community including attaining disability insurance for farm workers, and establishing the Dolores Huerta Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Huerta is most famously known for cofounding with César Chávez the National Farm Workers Association that organized the historic 1965 Grape String alongside the Agricultural Workers Organizing Committee; and

WHEREAS, Huerta/s efforts led to the adoption of the Agricultural Labor Relation Act in 1975 in the State of California that grants the right of farm workers to unionize; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach (the "City") aims to recognize the longlasting impact of the work on union organizing and labor negotiations by honoring a day to Dolores Huerta;

WHEREAS, the City is a leader in celebrating its diversity, supporting social justice and equity in the City, and fostering mutual respect and understanding for all; and NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby recognizes April 10th of every year in the City of Long Beach as Dolores Huerta Day in honor and observance of the contributions by Dolores Huerta to the Mexican community, to promote public awareness
