3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE
6 GORDIAN GROUP, INC. DBA THE MELLON GROUP IN
7 AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$341,250 FOR ACCESS
8 RIGHTS TO THEIR PROPRIETARY PRO-GEN
9 SOFTWARE AND TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL
10 SERVICES TO MANAGE THE JOC PROGRAM, THROUGH
11 THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CALIFORNIA STATE
12 UNIVERSITY AND THE GORDIAN GROUP, INC. DBA THE
13 MELLON GROUP

15 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
16 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
17 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
18 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

19 WHEREAS, The Gordian Group, Inc. dba The Mellon Group (the "Gordian
20 Group") provides the necessary support services, including the documentation and
21 software, that allow Job Order Contract ("JOC") contractors to produce the detailed
22 construction proposals for City consideration; and

23 WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract with the Gordian Group
24 for access rights to their proprietary Pro-Gen software and to provide professional
25 services to manage the JOC program; and

26 WHEREAS, California State University ("CSU") has an Agreement with the
27 Gordian Group for a Systemwide JOC System, Agreement No. 80246 ("CSU Contract");
28 and

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1 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the CSU Contract will facilitate
2 expeditious completion of a Systemwide Job Order Contract System as well as provide
3 considerable cost benefits to the City; and

4 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
5 CSU Contract considerably more funds would be required;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
7 follows:

8 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
9 herein by this reference.

10 Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
11 authorized to enter into an agreement with The Gordian Group, Inc. dba The Mellon
12 Group in an amount not to exceed \$341,250 for access rights to their proprietary Pro-Gen
13 software and to provide professional services, on substantially the same terms and
14 conditions afforded to CSU, for three (3) years with the option to renew for two (2)
15 additional one-year periods.

16 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
17 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
