FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 28619

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 28619 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of June 29, 2009 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on June 2, 2009, by and between HERITAGE ARCHITECTURE AND PLANNING (formerly known as Architect Milford Wayne Donaldson, FAIA, Inc.), a California corporation ("Consultant"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 28619 whereby Consultant agreed to provide specialized architectural design services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with the design of entryway and landscaping improvements, a Visitor's Center and caretaker residence at Rancho Los Cerritos Historic Site ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to again extend the term of the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Agreement and this Fifth Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of Agreement No. 28619 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"1. SCOPE OF SERVICES.

A. Consultant shall furnish specialized services more particularly set forth in Exhibit "A", to be attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, in accordance with the standards of the profession, and City shall pay for said services in the manner described below, not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00), at the rates or charges described in Exhibit "A". "

- 2. Section 2 of Agreement No. 28619 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "2. <u>TERM</u>. The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on April 30, 2007, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on May 1, 2011, unless sooner

TASK 1: PRELIMINARY PLAN PHASE

A. Colored Rendered Conceptual Plans

• Colored rendered conceptual plans for presentation and fundraising purposes shall be completed. Four (4) 24"x36" mounted presentation drawings showing views and elevations will be produced.

B. Design Development

- Survey areas as needed for drainage, fencing, roadwork, and construction.
- Create an update base plan.
- Develop and submit preliminary design plans for review and approval from the City of Long Beach Parks, Recreation and Marine Director, the City of Long Beach Public Works, Rancho Los Cerritos staff, Rancho Los Cerritos Foundation, Parks and Recreation Commission, and the Cultural Heritage Commission.

C. Project Meetings

- Prior to commencing planning, a kick-off meeting between the City of Long Beach, the Rancho Los Cerritos Foundation, and the Architect Milford Wayne Donaldson, FAIA Team to review the Master Plan concepts, Environmental Impact Report (EIR), and all existing historical photographs, history, architecture, cultural landscape, educational programs envisioned for this project.

TASK 2: CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS

- A. Upon approval of the preliminary design, preparation of construction documents shall be prepared consisting of plans and specifications, calculations and cost estimates setting forth in detail the requirements of the project. Submissions shall be at 50% and 90% to the Parks Recreation and Marine Department Director, Rancho Los Cerritos staff, and Public Works staff prior to finalization of the project.
- **B.** Assuming that all three project areas are awarded, the project shall be designed to be built in the following phases:
 - Entry Imperilments
 - Visitor Center and adjacent landscaping and parking adjustments
 - Caretaker Residence

C. Submissions

- Submission for Building, Electrical, Plumbing Mechanical and Fire Permits, as applicable, shall be conducted. Architect Milford Wayne Donaldson, FAIA shall monitor the progress of the plan checks on a weekly basis and shall make all necessary corrections to the satisfaction of the City of Long Beach Director of Planning and Building. Submission of approved plan check plans to the Public Works for final review and to ensure compliance with the City of Long Beach's Public Works standards, specifications, and constructability shall be conducted.
- All construction documents, specifications, and cost estimates shall be completed on AutoCAD 2002 and utilizing Microsoft Word and Excel software.

D. Deliverables

- Final vellum and digital construction plans ready for bid.
- Final technical specifications.
- Final estimate of probable construction costs. Cost estimates for entryway improvements shall be further broken down into the following components: pilasters, roadwork, wrought iron gate and fencing, security system, and landscaping.

E. Assist in Design Review Process

Assist the City in obtaining reviews and approvals from applicable public agencies shall include but not be limited to:

- Rancho Los Cerritos Foundation
- Parks and Recreation Commission
- Cultural Heritage Commission

F. Project Meetings

Two (2) project meetings have been delineated to include client meetings and possible participation in Commission meetings.
