

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 5.46.060 RELATING TO PUBLIC POSTING PROHIBITED

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 5.46.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

5.46.060 Public posting prohibited.

No person shall post notices on public property without a permit from the Public Works Department.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.

5.46.060 Public distribution posting prohibited.

No person shall post notices on public property without a permit from the Public Works Department. Except for the sale or distribution of newspapers, no person as principal, agent, employee, or otherwise shall solicit, whether verbally, written or otherwise, for any business, profession, trade, transportation line, excursion or any other purpose, in person, or by personally selling, offering for sale, or distributing any tickets, cards, handbills or other printed or written matter or merchandise in or upon any public street, alley, sidewalk, way, pier, wharf or other public place, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City, except as may be lawfully permitted under Chapter 5.66 of this Title 5. No person shall post notices on public property including street signs, lampposts, etc., without a permit from the Public Works Department.
