A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE

WHEREAS, the people of the County of Los Angeles on November 3, 1992, and on November 5, 1996 enacted Los Angeles County Proposition A, Safe Neighborhood Parks, Gang Prevention, Tree Planting, Senior and Youth Recreation, Beach and Wildlife Protection (the Propositions), which among other uses, provides funds to public agencies and nonprofit organizations in the County for the purpose of acquiring and/or development facilities and open space for public recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Propositions also created the Los Angeles County

WHEREAS, the District's procedures require the City of Long Beach to certify, by resolution, the approval of the application before submission of said application(s) to the District; and

WHEREAS, said application contains assurances that the City of Long Beach must comply with; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach will enter into an Agreement with the District to provide funds for acquisition and development projects;

Approves the filing of an application with the Los Angeles Section 1. County Regional Park and Open Space District for Fourth Supervisorial District Excess Funds for the above project; and

Certifies that the City of Long Beach understands the Section 2. assurances and certification in the application form; and

Certifies that the City of Long Beach has, or will have, Section 3. sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project in perpetuity; and

Appoints the City Manager, or designee, to conduct all Section 4. negotiations, and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so forth, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
