
Did You Know?


- Jonathan Jaques Children's Cancer Center (JJCCC) at Miller Children's & Women's Hospital Long Beach is a leader in pediatric cancer prevention, early detection, diagnosis, treatment and research
 - ALL Survival Rates 85-95% (30 yrs. ago 50%)
 - AML Survival Rates 50-60% (30 yrs. ago -20%)

(Through research efforts and in conjunction with all other children's hospitals)



Facts About Childhood Cancer







- Every 3 days we diagnose a new patient in our community
- We diagnosis patients from ages 0-21
- Teenagers treated at a children's hospital have almost twice the survival rate versus being treated at an adult cancer center



Facts About Childhood Cancer



Symptoms of Childhood Leukemia

- · Fatigue or pale skin
- · Infections and fever
- · Easy bleeding or bruising
- · Extreme fatigue or weakness
- · Shortness of breath
- Coughing

Other Symptoms May Include:

- . Bone or joint pain
- Swelling in the abdomen, face, arms, underarms, sides of neck, or groin
- Swelling above the collarbone
- Loss of appetite or weight loss
- Headaches, seizures, balance problems, or abnormal vision



- Rashes
- Gum problems

Leukemia is the most common form of cancer in childhood. It affects approximately 4,000 children each year in the U.S., accounting for about 1 in 3 of childhood cancers.

- Every day our pediatric Hematologist/Oncologist consult on 2-3 patients a physician suspects has cancer
- Our team helps train community providers about the warning signs of pediatric cancer and the importance of early detection
